Arrangement for conduct of election.

[1] On 18 June 2012 the Hobart Branch of the Musicians' Union of Australia lodged with Fair Work Australia the prescribed information in relation to an election for the following offices:

Branch Trustees	(3)

- [2] On 17 July 2012, the Secretary of the Hobart Branch lodged a request for an extension of time and for the exercise of the General Manager's discretion to allow a later day for lodgment of the prescribed information.
- [3] The notification of an election was overdue, the nominal 2 year term of office which commenced after the previous election having expired in December 2011. In his letter, the Secretary submitted reasons for the delay in lodging the prescribed information.
- [4] After considering all the circumstances, I am satisfied that the Secretary of the Hobart Branch is now aware of the requirements of the legislation and the rules of the organisation and will take steps to ensure compliance in the future. Under subsection 189(2) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009, I allow a later day for lodgment of the prescribed information up to the date of actual lodgment, namely 18 June 2012.

On the 18th June 2012, I lodged a Statement of Proscribed information in respect of offices for the Hobart

I refer to the Annual Return of Information lodged by the Federal Secretary under section 233(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 ('the Act') which was received by Fair Work Australia on 15 March 2012.

The Return lists, in accordance with regulation 147(e), the offices for which elections are due in 2012. These include all offices, with the exception of office of Secretary, in the Hobart Branch.

This letter is to remind you of the obligation to lodge prescribed information in respect of these offices.

Under the rules, elections for other offices must be held biennially. The last election conducted for the Branch was E2009/10031, granted on 18 August 2009 and declared on 9 December 2009. The expiry of the nominal term was therefore in December 2011 and prescribed information should have been lodged prior to that time. The election is therefore several months overdue.
