Re: Lodgement of Outstanding Financial Statements and Accounts – Musicians' Union of Australia, Launceston Branch – for years ending 30 June 2007 (FR2007/253), 30 June 2008 (FR2008/482)

Thank you for lodging the abovementioned financial returns.

I note that a single Secretary's Certificate was lodged. On the basis that it is otherwise clear that the financial statements for both years were provided to members and presented as certified at the same general meeting, and that certification might be said to apply equally to both, I have accepted the Certificate as pertaining to both returns, and a copy will be placed on the file for each.

I also draw your attention to the following for reference when preparing and finalising future reports.

Description as Special Purpose Financial Report

In the Notes to both returns, the Branch describes the report as a "special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the accounting preparation requirements of the constitution of......". and the Note continues by stating that the Musicians Union is "not a reporting entity as defined...."

The statement is incorrect for the purposes of the RAO Schedule. Pursuant to s242(3) the Branch is a reporting unit for the purposes of the RAO Schedule and is obliged under s253(1) to prepare a general purpose financial report. Section 253(2) sets out what the general purpose financial report must contain and it is not clear to the Registry – on the face of the documents – what, if anything, is preventing the Branch from preparing general purpose financial reports. Nothing in the documents lodged appear to prevent them from being characterised as general purpose financial reports.

The Branch must take steps to ensure that its financial reports meet the requirements of the Workplace Relations legislation and can be described as general purpose financial reports.

s272 Notice omitted

The Notice required under s272(5) of the RAO Schedule was omitted from both sets of documents. I attach a copy of the relevant text which must be included in future reports.

Auditor's statement

The auditor only stated that the financial statements complied with the "provisions of the Corporations Regulations 2001". Section 257(5) of the RAO Schedule requires the auditor to state whether the report is presented fairly in accordance with not only the Australian Accounting Standards, but also "other requirements imposed by this Part". This means, the RAO Schedule and Registrar Guidelines.

This section should be drawn to the auditor's attention when preparing future reports.

Apart from the above matters, the documents lodged meet the legislative requirements and accordingly they have both been filed. No further action is required in relation to them.

NOTE 1. Statement of Accounting Policies

These accounts are a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the accounting preparation requirements of the constitution of the Musicians Union of Australia Inc. The club officers have determined that the Musicians Union of Australia Inc. is not a reporting entity as defined in Statement of Accounting Concepts 1, Definition of the Reporting Entity, and therefore there is no requirement to apply accounting standards of other mandatory professional reporting requirements to the preparation and presentation of these statements. The accounts have been prepared on an accruals basis. They are based on historical costs and do not take into account changing money values, or except where specifically stated, current value of non-current assets. Accounting policies which have been applied are consistent with those of the previous period.


