Section 197(1) of Schedule 1 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 requires the AEC to provide a written report on the conduct of the election to the Delegate of the General Manager and to the organisation or branch for whom the election was conducted. If a website is not available, publishing a notice in a journal or newsletter would be considered appropriate.


