



[2] On 25 February 2013 The National Electrical Contractors Association lodged with the Fair Work Commission the prescribed information in relation to an election to fill a casual vacancy in the following office:

[3] In relation to the notification of four members of the Western Australia Chapter Council to be elected to the Western Australia Chapter Executive, the offices no longer exist under the rules of the Western Australia Chapter because they were deleted by rule alterations lodged after the prescribed information was lodged (see [2013] FWCD 3311; 30 May 2013).

[4] Therefore, with the exception of the offices cited in the preceding paragraph, I am satisfied that an election for the remainder of the offices notified in the prescribed information is required to be held under the rules of the organisation and, under subsection 189(3) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009, I am making arrangements for the conduct of the election by the Australian Electoral Commission.

[5] I note that the prescribed information does not request an election to be held for offices in relation to the Northern Territory Chapter 'the Chapter'. Correspondence dated 17 February 2009 indicated the Chapter was abolished by resolution of the National Executive of the organisation on 13 November 2008. I have been advised that further rule alterations will be transacted to abolish the Chapter. Nevertheless, the rules currently provide for the Chapter and its office holders, so prescribed information should have been lodged in relation to the Chapter. However, because no proscribed information has been lodged, I am unable to make arrangements for an election for offices in the Chapter at this time.
