Reminder of actions required when persons elected to office

The Australian Electoral Commission has provided the Registered Organisations Commission (the ROC) a declaration of results for the election of contested and uncontested offices in matter E2019/12. This letter is a reminder of certain obligations imposed on organisations and on persons elected to office.

A notice must be published on the organisation's website

The organisation or branch must, as soon as practicable after receiving the post-election report, publish on its website a notice that a copy of the report is available from the organisation, branch or the AEC on request. The notice must be kept on the website for a period of at least 3 months (see regulation 141 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009).

Holders of office required to undertake approved training

Section 293K of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the RO Act) requires each officer with financial management duties to undertake approved training that covers those duties within 6 months after the person begins to hold office. Please ensure that relevant officers undertake approved training within the required timeframe. Please also ensure that all new holders of office are advised of their obligations to make disclosures regarding remuneration, non-cash benefits and material personal interests, the details of which are provided for in the RO Act.

Organisation must notify the Commission of changes



Details:

As the rules are Silent on withdrawal of nominations the Returning Officer's exercised S 193 and advise the withdrawal of nominations closing date will be the same date as close of nominations closing date.

For the positions of National Office Bearers the dates for opening of nominations, closing of nominations, opening of ballot and closing of ballot as per their rules is unachievable, The Returning Officer exercised S.193 to determine suitable dates.

As there is a 7 day defect period there needs to be an extra week between close of nominations and ballot.

"...hire or otherwise arrange for a post office box or other post office receptacle to which ballot papers may be forwarded to him and arrange as far as possible that such box or receptacle shall not be available to be opened nor be opened by any persons other than himself."

This is not practical. The Returning Officer applied S.193 and advised the organisation that the ballot material will be returned through our usual post office box.

For the positions of National Office Bearers, Rule 18 (f) proposes an approximate two ballot period.

As it is a National Postal Ballot it is impractical for ballot papers to return to me nationally within two weeks, the Returning Officer proposed a four week ballot period.

Reminder of actions required when persons elected to office

The Australian Electoral Commission has provided the Registered Organisations Commission (the ROC) a declaration of results for the election of uncontested offices in matter E2019/12. This letter is a reminder of certain obligations imposed on organisations and on persons elected to office.

A notice must be published on the organisation's website

The organisation or branch must, as soon as practicable after receiving the post-election report, publish on its website a notice that a copy of the report is available from the organisation, branch or the AEC on request. The notice must be kept on the website for a period of at least 3 months (see regulation 141 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009).

Holders of office required to undertake approved training

Section 293K of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the RO Act) requires each officer with financial management duties to undertake approved training that covers those duties within 6 months after the person begins to hold office. Please ensure that relevant officers undertake approved training within the required timeframe. 
