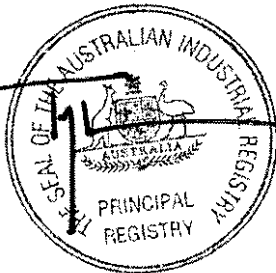

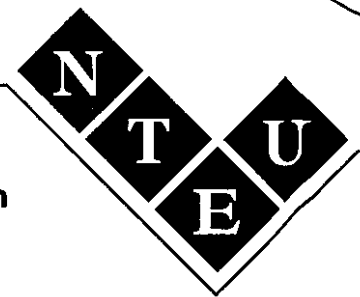

TO BE HELD.**

I, **GRAHAME MCCULLOCH**, General Secretary of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union, hereby request, pursuant to Section 214 of the Act, that the Registrar arrange for the conduct of this organisation's elections in 2003, and state as follows:

1. Elections are requested for those positions specified in the attached table, Attachment A.
2.
 - (a) **The name of each office (61(1)(a))** is specified in the first and second columns of Attachment A.
 - (b) **The reason for the election (61(1)(b))** is as specified in the fifth column of Attachment A, according to the Key to Election Request which is at Attachment B.
 - (c) **Where more than one of the offices in respect of which an election is required have the same name**, the number of such offices is as specified in the third column of Attachment A, headed "No. Required".
 - (d) **The electorate from which each office is to be elected** is as indicated in the fourth column of Attachment A, headed "Elected By", read in conjunction with Attachment B (61(1)(d)).
 - (e) **The voting system to be employed** in the conduct of the election is as indicated in the sixth column of Attachment A read in conjunction with Attachment B (61(1)(c)).
 - (f) **The period during which nominations may be called** is not fixed in respect of these elections, except that the University of Western Australia branch and South-West Institute of TAFE branch elections are required to be completed before 1st October 2003.
3.
