

REQUEST FOR AN ELECTION TO BE HELD

NATIONAL TERTIARY EDUCATION INDUSTRY UNION - REQUEST FOR ELECTIONS TO BE HELD.

I, GRAHAME MCCULLOCH, General Secretary of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union, hereby request, pursuant to Section 214 of the Act, that the Registrar arrange for the conduct of the National Indigenous elections, and state as follows:

- 1. Elections are required for those positions specified in the attached table, Attachment A.
- 2. (a) The name of each office (61(1)(a)) is specified in the first and second columns of Attachment A.
 - (b) The reason for the election (61(1)(b)) is as specified in the fifth column of Attachment A, according to the Key to Election Request which is at Attachment B.
 - (c) Where more than one of the offices in respect of which an election is required have the same name, the number of such offices is as specified in the third column of Attachment A, headed "No. Required".
 - (d) The electorate from which each office is to be elected is as indicated in the fourth column of Attachment A, headed "Elected By", read in conjunction with Attachment B (61(1)(d)).
 - (e) The voting system to be employed in the conduct of the election is as indicated in the sixth column of Attachment A read in conjunction with Attachment B (61(1)(c)).
 - (f) The period during which nominations may be called is from this date, to such date as would see the elections declared before 18th April 2003, except that no time is prescribed by the rules in relation to new positions.
- 3. The terms of office for each position in the attached table is from the declaration of this election until the declaration of the election of their successors in 2004.
- I have forwarded to the Australian Electoral Commission a copy of this request. It is our intention to request that nominations open on Friday 14 March 2003. It would therefore be appreciated, if possible, if this request could be approved by about 7th March 2003.
