



- I, CAROLYN ALLPORT, National President of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union, hereby request, pursuant to Section 214 of the Act, that the Registrar arrange for the conduct of the National Indigenous elections, and state as follows:
- Elections are required for those positions specified in the attached table, Attachment
 A.
- 2. (a) The name of each office (61(1)(a)) is specified in the first and second columns of Attachment A.
 - (b) The reason for the election (61(1)(b)) is as specified in the fifth column of Attachment A, according to the Key to Election Request which is at Attachment B.
