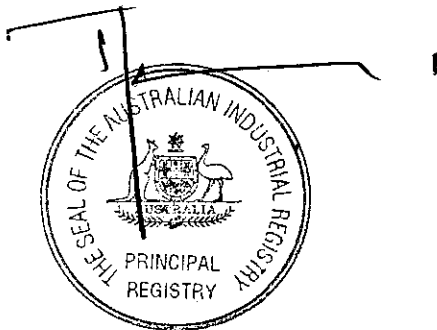
Arrangement for conduct of election.

 - (e) **The voting system to be employed** (138(1)(g)) in the conduct of the election is as indicated in the sixth column of Attachment A read in conjunction with Attachment B.
 - (f) **The period during which nominations may be called** (138(1)(e)) is 1 February 2005, to such date as would see the elections declared before 1 October 2005, except that no time is prescribed by the rules in relation to casual vacancies or unfilled positions.
3. The terms of office for each position in the attached table is two years, from 1 October 2004, or as otherwise provided in the rules, except that the positions of Branch Officers and Branch Committee in each of the South-West Institute of TAFE Branch and the University of Western Australia Branch, each of which has a one year term from 1 October 2005.
4. **The date provided for in the rules as the day on which the roll of voters is to be closed** (138(1)(f)) is the seventh day before the date determined for the opening of nominations in the election.

I have forwarded to the Australian Electoral Commission a copy of this request. It is our intention to request that nominations open in early February 2005. It would therefore be appreciated, if possible, if this request could be approved by the end of January 2005.
