Re: National Tertiary Education Industry Union - Request for Election to be Held

A casual vacancy has occurred in the NTEU for the position of Divisional National Executive Member, ACT Division, following the resignation of Rachael Bahl on 27 November 2009. A copy of Ms Bahl's resignation is attached.

Rule 80.3 requires that in the event of an extraordinary or casual vacancy occurring in the office of Division President, an election shall be held except in certain circumstances which are not applicable in this case. Therefore this application is made separately from the more general application which was lodged last Friday.

I hereby request, pursuant to Section 189 of Schedule 1 of the Act, that the General Manager arrange for the conduct of an election, and state the following prescribed information according to Regulation 138:

- The name of the office (138(1)(a)) is Divisional National Executive Member, Australian Capital Territory Division.
- The reason for the election (138(1)(b)) is that a casual vacancy has occurred (ii).
- The electorate from which the office is to be elected (138(1)(d)) is the ACT Division Council.
- The voting system to be employed (138(1)(g)) in the conduct of the election is a collegiate electoral system.
- The period during which nominations may be called (138(1)(e)) is not specified in the rules.
- The day provided for in the rules as the day on which the roll of voters is to be closed (138(1)(f)) is the seventh day before the date determined for the opening of nominations.

The initial assessment of the situation following Ms Bahl's resignation form Division President and Divisional National Executive Member (A.C.T.) was that, by virtue of changes made in to the Rules in 2008, the election of the Division President to this position at the ordinary election in 2008 "determined" (for the purpose of Schedule E, Rule 2 of the Rules) that the holder of the office of Division President, whomever that might be from time to time, is the holder of the office of Divisional National Executive Member for the balance of the 'term of office". However, after further reflection, we have taken counsel's advice, and on the basis of that advice we now lodge this request.

I certify that to the best of my knowledge and belief, the information is correct and based upon advice given by the relevant Division.
