I, **GRAHAME MCCULLOCH**, General Secretary of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union, hereby request, pursuant to Section 189 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009, that the General Manager arrange for the conduct of this organisation's elections in 2011, and state as follows:
