Organisation must respond to the post-election report of the Australian Electoral Commission: E2016/100

On 25 January 2017 the Fair Work Commission (the Commission) received a post election report from the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) for election E2016/100 dated 25 January 2017. The AEC will have also provided the report to the organisation under section 197 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the RO Act).

The report identifies rules that were difficult to interpret or apply, in particular rule(s) 72.15(b) and 18.5 B. This letter serves as a reminder of the obligations imposed on the organisation or branch as a consequence of the AEC's report. If a response has already been sent to the AEC and made available to all members please disregard this letter.

A notice must be published on the organisation's website

The organisation or branch must publish on its website a notice that a copy of the report is available from the organisation, branch or the AEC on request. The notice must be kept on the website for a period of at least 3 months (see regs 141(4) and (5)).

A written response must be provided to the AEC

A written response must be provided to the AEC within 30 days of receipt of the report. The organisation's response must include whether the organisation or branch intends to take action and if so what action the organisation or branch intends to take (s198(2)).

Extract of report must be made available to members

The organisation or branch must make the section of the report relating to the difficult rules available to its members (s198(3)). This extract from the report must be made available to the members before or at the same time as the organisation's response is made available to members.

Written response must be made available to members

A copy of the organisation's response to the AEC must be made available to members either:

- within 30 days after the response is given to the AEC, or
- published in the next edition of the organisation or branch journal (s198(5))

Subsection 198(6) and regulation 142 prescribe ways in which the relevant extract and the copy of the response can be made available to members. These do not limit the ways in which they can be made available to members. The organisation will comply if it does all of the following:-

 publish the report extract and the copy of the response in the next edition of the organisation or branch's journal; and

- within 30 days of giving the response to the AEC:
 - lodges with the Commission a copy of the relevant extract and response, together with a declaration that a copy will be provided to any member who so requests; and
 - give notice in the next edition of the organisation or branch's journal, or an appropriate newspaper, that a copy of the relevant extract and response are available on request to each member free of charge; and
- publish the relevant extract on the website within 14 days after receiving the report, and publish the response on the website within 14 days of giving the response to the AEC (reg 142(2)).

Penalties may apply

If the organisation or branch does not:

- respond to the AEC within 30 days,
- make the extract of the report relating to the rules available to members no later than the organisation's response is made available to members, or
- make the organisation's response available to members within 30 days or in the next edition of the journal,

the organisation may face penalties under the RO Act. Each requirement listed above is a civil penalty provision that may result in fines for the organisation

If the organisation or branch decides to alter its rules in response to the AEC's report

Reminder of actions required when persons elected to office

The Australian Electoral Commission has provided the Fair Work Commission (the Commission) a declaration of results for the election of uncontested/contested offices/positions for [E2016/100]. This letter is a reminder of certain obligations imposed on organisations and on persons elected to office.

A notice must be published on the organisation's website

The organisation or branch must publish on its website a notice that a copy of the report is available from the organisation, branch or the AEC on request. The notice must be kept on the website for a period of at least 3 months (see regulation 141 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009).

Holders of office required to undertake approved training

Section 154D(1) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the RO Act) requires the rules of organisations (and branches of organisations) to require each officer with financial management duties to undertake approved training that covers those duties within 6 months after the person begins to hold office. Please ensure that relevant officers undertake approved training within the required timeframe. A list of approved training providers is attached.

Please also ensure that all new holders of office are advised of their obligations to make disclosures regarding remuneration, non-cash benefits and material personal interests, the details of which should be provided for in your organisation's rules.

Organisation must notify the Commission of changes

Also, section 233(2) of the RO Act requires that an organisation must notify the Commission within 35 days of any changes to the holders of office in the organisation. If there are no changes a notification is not required. If the election has resulted in any changes to the holders of office, the National Tertiary Education Industry Union must notify the Commission of these changes. In particular, please advise:

- 1. Person(s) who have ceased to hold office:
 - the name of the office vacated;
 - the date of the change of office holder; and
 - the name of the person vacating the office.
- 2. Person(s) who have commenced to hold office:

- the name of the office now held;
- the date of the change of office holder;
- the name of the person now holding the office;
- the postal address of the person (generally the postal address of the organisation); and
- the occupation of the person now holding the office.

The notification must include a declaration by the Secretary (or other prescribed officer) that the information is a correct statement of the changes made. A template notification of changes, which may assist you, is attached. If any change does not apply until a date in the future, you do not need to notify until then (e.g. AGM, 1 January, 2nd Monday in March). If you have already lodged this information, please disregard this reminder.



Reminder of actions required when persons elected to office

The Australian Electoral Commission has provided the Fair Work Commission (the Commission) a declaration of results for the election [E2016/100] for Queensland and Northern Territory Divisions. This letter is a reminder of certain obligations imposed on organisations and on persons elected to office.

A notice must be published on the organisation's website

The organisation or branch must publish on its website a notice that a copy of the report is available from the organisation, branch or the AEC on request. The notice must be kept on the website for a period of at least 3 months (see regulation 141 of the *Fair Work (Registered organisations) Regulations* 2009).

Holders of office required to undertake approved training

Section 154D(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (the RO Act) requires the rules of organisations (and branches of organisations) to require each officer with financial management duties to undertake approved training that covers those duties within 6 months after the person begins to hold office. Please ensure that relevant officers undertake approved training within the required timeframe.

Please also ensure that all new holders of office are advised of their obligations to make disclosures regarding remuneration, non-cash benefits and material personal interests, the details of which should be provided for in your organisation's rules.

Organisation must notify the Commission of changes

If any change does not apply until a specific date, you don't need to notify until then (e.g. AGM, 1 January, 2nd Monday in March). If you have already lodged this information, please disregard this reminder.

I, **GRAHAME McCULLOCH**, General Secretary of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union, hereby request, pursuant to Section 189 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009, that the General Manager arrange for the conduct of this organisation's elections in 2016, and state as follows:

- 1. Elections are required for those offices specified in the attached table, Attachment B.
- 2.
- (a) **The name of each office** (Regulation 138(1)(a)) is specified in the first and second columns of Attachment B.
- (b) **The reason for the election** (138(1)(b)) is as specified in the fifth column of Attachment B, according to the Key to Election Request which is at the Annexure to Attachment B.
- (c) Where more than one of the offices in respect of which an election is required have the same name (138(1)(c)) the number of such offices is as specified in the third column of Attachment B, headed "No. Required".
- (d) The electorate from which each office is to be elected (138(1)(d)) is as indicated in the fourth column of Attachment B, headed "Elected By", read in conjunction with the Annexure to Attachment B.
- (e) **The voting system to be employed** (138(1)(g)) in the conduct of the election is as indicated in the sixth column of Attachment B read in conjunction with the Annexure to Attachment B.
- (f) The period during which nominations may be called (138(1)(e)) is 1 February 2016, to such date as would see the elections declared before the terms of office commence, except that no time is prescribed by the rules in relation to new positions. To be determined by the returning officer.
- 3. The terms of office for each office in the attached table is two years, except for the positions of Division Secretary in the Australian Capital Territory, New South Wales, South Australian and Western Australian Divisions, which are designated as full-time offices (Rule 69.8). No election is required for Division Secretary in the Queensland and Victorian Divisions, which have four year terms from 2014.

- 4. I have included in Attachment B in the left hand column in respect of each Branch where it is relevant in determining the number of National Councillors a Branch is to elect, the number of members of the Branch (Rule 18.1). This number is in brackets e.g. ("897"). The listed number is based, as required by the rules on the membership numbers according to the best records held by the General Secretary as at 29 February 2016 (Rule 18.1).
- 5. Specifically, you will note that the Victorian TAFE Branch has a National Councillor to be elected and the ACE and Companies Branch has a National Councillor to be elected, pursuant to the terms of Sub-Rule 18.3.
- 6. The date provided for in the rules as the day on which the roll of voters is to be closed (138(1)(f)) is the seventh day before the date determined for the opening of nominations (72.1).
- 7. In accordance with Rule 18.3 I, an election is only requested for the position of Indigenous Branch Committee Member at those Branches where, according to the Union's records today, the Union has Indigenous members. I have caused the records of the Union to be checked in respect of each Branch and the requests corresponds to the result of that check.
- 8. I can confirm that each of the entities, other than the ANU Branch, entitled to elect an Additional Divisional Councillor in the ACT Division has less than 400 members.
- 9. I can confirm that the University of Tasmania Branch continues to be the only Branch in Tasmania.
- 10. The University of South Australia has passed a motion at a Branch Committee meeting after holding a general meeting to change the number of Ordinary Committee Members on the Branch from 11 to 6.
- 11. You will note that the University of Western Sydney Branch has changed name to now be Western Sydney University Australia Branch. Following the change in the name of the institution.
- 12. The Monash University Branch Changed the name of their sub-Branch from Pharmacy Campus Sub-Branch to Monash College Sub-Branch to reflect the name change at the campus
- 13. The Deakin University Branch at a Branch committee meeting abolished its Sub-Branches which were formally Geelong Sub-Branch, Melbourne Sub-Branch and Warrnambool Sub-Branch.
- 14. The University of Queensland abolished it's Ipswich Sub-Branch due to the campus being sold to another university and therefore no longer having any members at this sub-branch.

15. The National Executive, by resolution at its meeting held in February 2016, passed the following resolution giving effect to these changes and re-constituting the Branch.

Whereas, in April 2008, the National Executive passed a resolution establishing a sector Branch known as the Victorian TAFE Branch, the National Executive now determines to reconstitute the Branch to consist of members of the Union employed in or in connection with the following or their successors):

In accordance with section 36.3 of the Rules, the National Executive further determines that the Victorian TAFE Branch Committee shall consist of the Presidents of each of the Sub-Branches, and an Indigenous representative in accordance with Rule 18.3(I).

The sub-branches are hereby reconstituted such that there is one sub-branch for each institution listed above.

Executive notes that under the 2008 resolution, the persons employed at the body known as the Centre for Adult Education are now members of the Victorian TAFE Branch.

- 16. You will note that the Victorian TAFE Branch has a National Councillor and the ACE and Companies Branch has a National Councillor, pursuant to the terms of Sub-Rule 18.3.
- 17. As per rule 27.14 there are no Branches of the Union established in the Northern Territory and the Division Officers and Division Council in the Northern Territory Division shall be as set out in this sub-rule

18. Attachment C to this statement sets out those positions which are required to be elected under the Rules of the NTEU but which are not considered to be offices as defined in Section 9 of the Fair Work (RO) Act 2009. NTEU requests that the elections for these positions be conducted by the AEC in accordance with s.187 of the Fair Work (RO) Act 2009.
