Organisation must respond to the post-election report of the Australian Electoral Commission: E2019/22

On 04/09/2019 the Registered Organisations Commission (the ROC) received a post election report from the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) for election E2019/22. The AEC will have also provided the report to the organisation under section 197 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* (the RO Act).

The report identifies rules that were difficult to interpret or apply, in particular Rule 72.15(b). This letter serves as a reminder of the obligations imposed on the organisation or branch as a consequence of the AEC's report. If a response has already been sent to the AEC and made available to all members please disregard this letter.

A notice must be published on the organisation's website

The organisation or branch must publish on its website a notice that a copy of the report is available from the organisation, branch or the AEC on request. The notice must be kept on the website for a period of at least 3 months (see regs 141(4) and (5)).

A written response must be provided to the AEC

A written response must be provided to the AEC within 30 days of receipt of the report. The organisation's response must include whether the organisation or branch intends to take action and if so what action the organisation or branch intends to take (s198(2)).

Extract of report must be made available to members

The organisation or branch must make the section of the report relating to the difficult rules available to its members (s198(3)). This extract from the report must be made available to the members before or at the same time as the organisation's response is made available to members.

Written response must be made available to members

A copy of the organisation's response to the AEC must be made available to members either:

- within 30 days after the response is given to the AEC, or
- published in the next edition of the organisation or branch journal (s198(5))

Subsection 198(6) and regulation 142 prescribe ways in which the relevant extract and the copy of the response can be made available to members. These do not limit the ways in which they can be made available to members. The organisation will comply if it does all of the following:-

- publish the report extract and the copy of the response in the next edition of the organisation or branch's journal; and
- within 30 days of giving the response to the AEC:
 - lodges with the ROC a copy of the relevant extract and response, together with a declaration that a copy will be provided to any member who so requests; and
 - give notice in the next edition of the organisation or branch's journal, or an appropriate newspaper, that a copy of the relevant extract and response are available on request to each member free of charge; and
- publish the relevant extract on the website within 14 days after receiving the report, and publish the response on the website within 14 days of giving the response to the AEC (reg 142(2)).

Penalties may apply

If the organisation or branch does not:

- respond to the AEC within 30 days.
- make the extract of the report relating to the rules available to members no later than the organisation's response is made available to members, or
- make the organisation's response available to members within 30 days or in the next edition of the journal,

the organisation may face penalties under the RO Act. Each requirement listed above is a civil penalty provision that may result in fines for the organisation

As noted above, if the response and report have already been made available to members and the AEC, please disregard this letter. If you have any questions in relation to these obligations please contact the ROC for assistance by email to regorgs@roc.gov.au.

If the organisation or branch decides to alter its rules in response to the AEC's report

If the organisation or branch decides to alter its rules in response to the AEC's report, the ROC is NOT able to provide advice and assistance regarding draft alterations or the processes required to make the alterations. Rule alterations remain a function of the Fair Work Commission.

Reminder of actions required when persons elected to office

The Australian Electoral Commission has provided the Registered Organisations Commission (the ROC) a declaration of results for the election of uncontested offices in matter E2019/22. This letter is a reminder of certain obligations imposed on organisations and on persons elected to office.

A notice must be published on the organisation's website

The organisation or branch must, as soon as practicable after receiving the post-election report, publish on its website a notice that a copy of the report is available from the organisation, branch or the AEC on request. The notice must be kept on the website for a period of at least 3 months (see regulation 141 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009).

Holders of office required to undertake approved training

Section 293K of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (the RO Act) requires each officer with financial management duties to undertake approved training that covers those duties within 6 months after the person begins to hold office. Please ensure that relevant officers undertake approved training within the required timeframe. Please also ensure that all new holders of office are advised of their obligations to make disclosures regarding remuneration, non-cash benefits and material personal interests, the details of which are provided for in the RO Act.

Organisation must notify the Commission of changes

Also, section 233(2) of the RO Act requires that an organisation must notify the Commission within 35 days of any changes to the holders of office in the organisation. If there are no changes a notification is not required. If the election has resulted in any changes to the holders of office, the National Tertiary Education Industry Union must notify the Commission of these changes. In particular, please advise:

 - the name of the office vacated;
 - the date of the change of office holder; and
 - the name of the person vacating the office.
- 2. Person(s) who have commenced to hold office:
 - the name of the office now held;
 - the date of the change of office holder;
 - the name of the person now holding the office;
 - the postal address of the person (generally the postal address of the organisation); and
 - the occupation of the person now holding the office.

The notification must include a declaration by the Secretary (or other prescribed officer) that the information is a correct statement of the changes made. A template notification of changes, which may assist you, is attached. If any change does not apply until a date in the future, you do not need to notify until then (e.g. AGM, 1 January, 2nd Monday in March). If you have already lodged this information, please disregard this reminder.

Rules difficult to apply/interpret: Rule 72.15(b) requires extension of the closing date for nomination

This rule does not allow time to check the eligibility of candidates or to allow time for a defect period which usually occurs in these elections. Besides, the rule also allows for a seven day withdrawal period after the close of initial nomination period. Therefore, the unfilled offices cannot be confirmed until the declaration has

been issued for the initial call of nominations.

The declaration can take up to 10 to 14 days leaving insufficient nomination period for the calling of nominations for the unfilled

positions.

It is recommended that the recall of nominations should close 14 days after the date of declaration which confirms the number of unfilled offices to be recalled. This action provides for a 14 day nomination period which reflects the minimum period for the

calling of nominations.

Reminder of actions required when persons elected to office

The Australian Electoral Commission has provided the Registered Organisations Commission (the ROC) a declaration of results for the election of uncontested offices in matter E2019/22. This letter is a reminder of certain obligations imposed on organisations and on persons elected to office.

A notice must be published on the organisation's website

The organisation or branch must, as soon as practicable after receiving the post-election report, publish on its website a notice that a copy of the report is available from the organisation, branch or the AEC on request. The notice must be kept on the website for a period of at least 3 months (see regulation 141 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009).

Holders of office required to undertake approved training

Section 293K of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (the RO Act) requires each officer with financial management duties to undertake approved training that covers those duties within 6 months after the person begins to hold office. - (e) **The voting system to be employed** (138(1)(g)) in the conduct of the election is as indicated in the sixth column of Attachment B read in conjunction with the Annexure to Attachment B.
- (f) The period during which nominations may be called (138(1)(e)) no time is prescribed by the rules.
- 3. These elections may be held, under the rules of the NTEU. The term of office for each position in the attached table is the remainder of the two year term to which the previous incumbent was elected in 2018.
- 4. The date provided for in the rules as the day on which the roll of voters is to be closed (138(1)(f)) is the seventh day before the date determined for the opening of nominations (72.1).
- 5. In accordance with Rule 18.3 I, an election is not requested for the position of Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Branch Committee Member at those Branches

where, according to the Union's records today, the Union has no Indigenous members, and that position is vacant or has become vacant since the 2018 elections.

- 6. Attachment C to this statement sets out those positions which are required to be elected under the Rules of the NTEU but which are not considered to be offices as defined in Section 9 of the Fair Work (RO) Act 2009. NTEU requests that the elections for these positions be conducted by the AEC in accordance with s.187 of the Fair Work (RO) Act 2009.
- 7. I have forwarded to the Australian Electoral Commission a copy of this request. It is our hope to advertise nominations from mid May 2019. It would therefore be appreciated, if possible, if this request could be approved as soon as possible.
