This is a courtesy letter to remind you of the financial reporting obligations of the abovenamed body under the *Workplace Relations Act 1996* ('the Act') for the financial year ended 30 June, 2002.

The legislative scheme set out in Part IX, Division 11 of the Act is directed at ensuring that a registered organisation or a branch of such an organisation discharges obligations of accountability to its members in relation to its financial affairs through proper and regular disclosure of financial information. The various steps of the financial reporting requirements must be carried out within the time-scales prescribed by the legislation so as to ensure the relevance of the financial information provided to the members.

Now that the financial year has ended, it is timely that you put in train the various steps of the financial reporting requirements. To assist you with this process I have enclosed for your information a notice summarising these requirements including the time-scales prescribed by the legislation.

### NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2002

### NOTE 1: STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

This financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act 1985 (SA) (as amended). The Committee has determined that the association is not a reporting entity.

The financial report has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act 1985 (SA) (as amended) and the following Australian Accounting Standards:

AAS5 Materiality
AAS6 Accounting Policies

AAS8 Events occurring after Balance Date.

No other applicable Accounting Standards, Urgent Issues Group Consensus Views or other authoritative pronouncements by the Australian Accounting Standards Board have been applied.

The financial report has been prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historical costs and does not take into account changing money values, or, except where stated, current valuations of non-current assets. The following material accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this Financial Report.

#### (a) Income Tax

The Union is an exempt organisation under Section 23(f) of the Income Tax Assessment Act, and has no liability to pay income tax.

#### (b) Fixed Assets

The depreciable amount of plant and equipment are depreciated over their useful lives commencing from the time the asset is held ready for use.

#### (c) Employment Benefits

Provision is made in respect of the Union's liability to employees for annual and long service leave at balance date. As the employees have been transferred from another association, the entitlements due to these employees up until the date of transfer have remained with those associations. The Union has only recognised in its accounts the amounts due from when these employees commenced service with the Union and only to the extent that they have not been provided for in the accounts of the other association.

Contributions are made by the Union to an employees superannuation fund and are charged as expenses when incurred. The Union has no legal obligation to provide benefits to employees on retirement.

### (d) Goods and Services Tax (GST)

The Union accounts for GST on the cash basis of accounting and is not registered for GST. All GST transactions are reported and paid to the Australian Taxation Office by the National Body of the Union.

### **WORKPLACE RELATIONS ACT 1996**

Section 274 - Information to be provided to members or Registrar

274(1) A member of an organisation or a Registrar may apply to the organisation for specified prescribed information in relation to the organisation.

274(2) An organisation shall, on application made under section (1) by a member of the organisation or a Registrar, make the specified information available to the member or a Registrar in such manner, and within such time, as is prescribed.

274(3) A Registrar may only make an application under subsection (2) at the request of a member of the organisation concerned, and the Registrar shall provide to a member information received because of an application made at the request of the member.

### SCOPE

We have audited the financial report, being a special purpose financial report of the Adelaide University Branch of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union, comprising the Income and Expenditure Statement, Balance Sheet, Notes to and forming part of the Accounts, Accounting Officer's Certificate and Committee of Management Certificate for the year ended 30 June 2002. The Committee of Management is responsible for the financial report and has determined that the accounting policies used and described in Note 1 to the of the financial statements which form part of the Financial Report are appropriate to meet the needs of members. We have performed an independent audit of this financial report in order to express an opinion on it to the members of the Union. No opinion is expressed as to whether the accounting policies used, and described in Note 1, are appropriate to the needs of the members.

These policies do not require the application of all Accounting Standards and other mandatory professional reporting requirements in Australia.

The audit opinion expressed in this report has been formed on the above basis.
