
The legislative scheme set out in Part IX, Division 11 of the Act is directed at ensuring that a registered organisation or a branch of such an organisation discharges obligations of accountability to its members in relation to its financial affairs through proper and regular disclosure of financial information. The various steps of the financial reporting requirements must be carried out within the time-scales prescribed by the legislation so as to ensure the relevance of the financial information provided to the members.

Now that the financial year has ended, it is timely that you put in train the various steps of the financial reporting requirements. To assist you with this process I have enclosed for your information a notice summarising these requirements including the time-scales prescribed by the legislation.



NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE 2002

1. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

This financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the Trustees' accountability requirements under the Unions' Rules and the requirements under the Workplace Relations Act 1996 to prepare a financial report. The Trustees' have determined that the Union is not a reporting entity.

The financial report has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, and the following Australian Accounting Standards.

- AAS 4 Depreciation of Non-Current Assets
- AAS 5 Materiality
- AAS 8 Events Occurring After Reporting Date

No other applicable Australian Accounting Standards, Urgent Issues Group Consensus Views or other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board have been applied.

The financial report has been prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historic costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following material accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this report:

(a) Plant & Equipment

Depreciation is provided on all fixed assets so as to write off the assets progressively over their estimated economic lives. The prime cost method of depreciation is used.

- (b) Provision for Employee Entitlements
 - The provision relates to annual leave and long service leave and has been calculated on the basis of actual entitlements under appropriate awards, based on current wage rates.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE 2002

1. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (cont.)

(c) Income Tax

No income tax has been provided, as the Branch is exempt from income tax pursuant to section 50-15 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.

(d) Information to be provided to members or registrar

In accordance with the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, as amended, the attention of members is drawn to the provisions of sub-section (1) (2) and (3) of section 274, which reads as follows:

- (1) A member of an organisation or Registrar may apply to the organisation for specified prescribed information in relation to the organisation.
- (2) An Organisation shall, on application made under subsection (1) by members of the organisation or a Registrar, make the specified information available to the member or Registrar in such manner, and within such time as prescribed.
- (3) A Registrar may only make an application under sub-section (1) at the request of a member of the organisation concerned, and the Registrar shall provide to a member information received because of an application made at the request of the members.

We have audited the financial report, being a special purpose financial report set out on pages 1 to 9 of the National Tertiary Education Union – University of Ballarat Branch for the year ended 30^{th} June 2002. The Branch Committee is responsible for the financial report and has determined that the accounting policies used and described in Note 1 to the financial statements which form part of the financial report are appropriate to the needs of the Workplace Relations Act and the needs of the members. We have conducted an independent audit of this financial report in order to express an opinion on it to the members of the National Tertiary Education Union – University of Ballarat Branch. No opinion is expressed as to whether the accounting policies used are appropriate to the needs of the members.

The financial report has been prepared for the purpose of fulfilling the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act. These policies do not require the application of all Accounting Standards and other mandatory professional reporting requirements in Australia.

I refer to the lodgement of financial documents for the years ended 30 June 2001 and 2002. The documents were received in this office on 15 November 2002.

While the documents have been filed, the following matters are drawn to your attention to assist in the preparation of future financial documents.

1. Certificates not dated

It is noted that the accounting officer's certificate and committee of management certificate are both undated for both financial years. All certificates should be dated as a matter of course to ensure that the auditor considers both the accounting officer's certificate and the committee of management certificate for each financial year.

2. Legislative Timescale Provisions

Section 279(6) of the *Workplace Relations Act 1996* requires that the financial documents be presented to the stipulated meeting **no less than 8 days after circulation** and no more than 84 days after the auditor's report. Your certificate indicates that the documents for both financial years were presented to a Branch meeting of members less than 8 days after circulation.

3. Late lodgement of financial documents for year ended 30 June 2001

Should similar circumstances arise in the future, an extension of time pursuant to s.279(3) of the *Workplace Relations Act 1996* should be sought from the Industrial Registrar as soon as it is known that the prescribed time limits may not be met.
