#### 271(1) Application NTEU – Curtin University Branch

The Curtin Branch of the NTEU exists largely on paper, as its business is effectively carried out by Curtin University Staff Association (CUSA). CUSA is an incorporated association, registered under the WA *Associations Incorporation Act 1987*.

This association collects fees on behalf of itself and the NTEU. It passes on a proportion of these fees to the NTEU National Office, and to the NTEU WA Division as required by them. Apart from procedural items all business is conducted by CUSA and then formally adopted by the NTEU branch. CUSA also holds all monies and property.

Consequently the Branch holds no property real or personal, has no funds, nor does it engage in any financial transactions.

Under the CUSA constitution all NTEU Branch members are automatically CUSA members and NTEU Branch office bearers are automatically CUSA office bearers.

We therefore request exemption under subsection 271(1) of Schedule B of the Workplace Relations Act 1996 for the financial year ending June 2006.
