Re: National Tertiary Education Industry Union-Edith Cowan University Branch Financial Reporting Obligations under Workplace Relations Act 1996

This is a courtesy letter to remind you of the financial reporting obligations of the abovenamed body under the Workplace Relations Act 1996 ('the Act') for the financial year ended 30 June, 2003.

While the accounting, auditing and reporting obligations have changed with the introduction of the *Registration and Accountability of Organisations* Schedule (the RAO Schedule) which generally came into operation on 12 May 2003, Part IX, Division 11 of the Act continues to apply in relation to a financial year of an organisation that ends on 30 June, 2003. The corresponding obligations set out in the RAO Schedule apply to each financial year of an organisation that starts on or after 1 July 2003.

Now that the financial year for 30 June, 2003 has ended, it is timely that you put in train the various steps of the financial reporting requirements. To assist you with this process I have enclosed for your information a notice summarising these requirements including the time-scales prescribed by the legislation.

Please note that a branch of an organisation may be exempted from the obligations arising under Part IX, Division 11 in respect of a financial year by satisfying a Registrar that the branch did not have any financial affairs during the financial year. An application under subsection 271A(1) of the Act must be made within 90 days (unless extended by a Registrar) after the end of the financial year.

## NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2003

### 1. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

This financial report is a special purpose financial report which has been prepared for the sole purpose of presenting accounts to the members of the Edith Cowan University Branch of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union at its annual general meeting. In the opinion of the Management Committee, the Edith Cowan University Branch of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union is not a reporting entity because it does not believe there are likely to be any other users of the Branch's accounts.

The financial report has been prepared in accordance with Australian Accounting Standards AAS 5 "Materiality", and AAS 6 "Accounting Policies". No other Australian Accounting Standards, Urgent Issues Group Consensus Views or other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board have been applied.

The financial report has been prepared on an accrual basis and is based on historic costs and does not take into account changing money values. The preparation of the financial report on an accruals basis is a change in accounting policy from prior years.

The accounts have been prepared on a going concern basis. The ability for the union to continue as a going concern is dependent on receiving membership dues.

The following is a summary of the significant accounting policies adopted by the Edith Cowan University Branch of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union in the preparation of this financial report.

### (a) Depreciation

Depreciation is provided on a straight-line basis on all property, plant and equipment, other than freehold land, at rates calculated to allocate the cost against revenue over their estimated useful lives.

### (b) Membership

Membership income is brought to account when receivable.

### 2. INCOME TAX

The Edith Cowan University Branch of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union is exempt from income tax.

### 3. PAYROLL TAX LIABILITY AND RECOVERY OF INDUSTRIAL OFFICER'S COSTS

The Edith Cowan University Branch of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union has agreed to pay to the WA Division of the NTEU the money determined by the Division as the ECU Branch's contribution calculated on a pro rata basis towards:

- (a) the arrears of payroll tax due and payable to the NTEU WA Division (not including any penalty tax)
- (b) the payment of one half of the salary of an industrial officer for the period 1 July to 31 December 2003

At 30 June 2003, the NTEU WA Division had not confirmed this amount but the estimated liability was \$19,933.

Since 1 July 2003, the ECU Branch of the NTEU has agreed to pay to the NTEU WA Division a further sum of money towards the establishment of a provision and contingency fund for long service, annual and sick leave for all WA Division employees.

The ECU Branch's contribution to this fund has been estimated by the Division calculated on a pro rata basis to be \$10,114.

The Academic Staff Association of Edith Cowan University (Inc.) has agreed to assist in the payment of the above liabilities and since balance date has contributed \$30,000 towards payment of same.

### 4. EMPLOYEE BENEFITS

It is proposed that the Office Manager of the Academic Staff Association of Edith Cowan University (Inc.) currently employed by the association be employed by the Edith Cowan University Branch of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union. It is proposed that the union will take over the employee benefits outstanding. We have not provided in the financial statements for the leave liability for the Office Manager. The estimated current liability is \$628.72 and the non-current liability is \$850.18.



### SECTION 274: INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED TO MEMBERS OR REGISTRAR

### 274(1) Application For Information

A member of an organization, or a Registrar, may apply to the organization for specified prescribed information in relation to the organization.

### 274(2) Provision of Information

An organization shall, on application made under subsection (1) by a member of the organization or a Registrar, make the specified information available to the member or Registrar in such manner, and within such time, as is prescribed.

### 274(3) Function of Registrar

A Registrar may only make an application under subsection (1) at the request of a member of the organization concerned, and the Registrar shall provide to a member information received because of an application made at the request of the member.

### 274(4) Notice in Accounts

Accounts prepared under section 273 shall include a notice drawing attention to subsections (1), (2) and (3) and setting out those subsections.

### SECTION 273: ORGANISATION TO PREPARE ACCOUNTS ETC.

### 273(1) Prescription

As soon as practicable after the end of each financial year, an organization:

- (a) shall cause to be prepared from the accounting records kept by the organization under subsection 272(1) in relation to the financial year, such accounts and other statements, in relation to the financial year, as are prescribed; and
- (b) shall include in the accounts (other than accounts prepared in relation to the first financial year of the organization to which this Division applies) the relevant figures from the accounts prepared by the organization, under this subsection, in relation to the preceding financial year.

### 273(2) Certificates

The regulations may provide for the giving of certificates in, or in relation to, accounts or other statements prepared under subsection (1).

### SECTION 272: ORGANISATION TO KEEP PROPER ACCOUNTING RECORDS

### 272(1) Prescription An organization shall:

- (a) keep such accounting records as correctly record and explain the transactions and financial position of the organization, including such records as are prescribed;
- (b) keep its accounting records in such a manner as will enable accounts and statements to be prepared from them under section 273; and
- (c) keep its accounting records in such a manner as will enable the accounts of the organization to be conveniently and properly audited under this Division.

### 272(2) Cash or accrual basis

Accounting records of an organization may, so far as they relate to the income and expenditure of the organization, be kept on a cash basis or accrual basis, at the option of the organization.

The regulations may provide for the giving of certificates in, or in relation to, accounts or other statements prepared under subsection (1).

### SECTION 272: ORGANISATION TO KEEP PROPER ACCOUNTING RECORDS

### **272(1) Prescription** An organization shall:

- (a) keep such accounting records as correctly record and explain the transactions and financial position of the organization, including such records as are prescribed;
- (b) keep its accounting records in such a manner as will enable accounts and statements to be prepared from them under section 273; and
- (c) keep its accounting records in such a manner as will enable the accounts of the organization to be conveniently and properly audited under this Division.

### 272(2) Cash or accrual basis

Accounting records of an organization may, so far as they relate to the income and expenditure of the organization, be kept on a cash basis or accrual basis, at the option of the organization.
