NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2003

NOTE 1: STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

This financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act 1985 (SA) (as amended). The Committee has determined that the organization is not a reporting entity.

The financial report has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act 1985 (SA) (as amended) and the following Australian Accounting Standards:

Events Occurring After Reporting Date

No other applicable Australian Accounting Standards, Urgent Issues Group consensus Views or other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board have been applied.

The financial report has been prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historical costs and does not take into account changing money values, or, except where stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following material accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this financial report:

(a) <u>Member Subscriptions</u>

Amounts received by the National Tertiary Education Industry Union (NTEU) on behalf of the Universities Staff Association of South Australia (USASA) are retained by NTEU and treated as income of that organization. This income is paid out as expenses on behalf of USASA.

(b) <u>Income Tax</u>

The organization is an endorsed exempt organization under Section 23(f) of the Income Tax Assessment Act, and has no liability to pay income tax.

(c) Fixed Assets

The depreciable amounts of plant and equipment are depreciated over their useful lives commencing from the time the assets are held ready for use.

The carrying amount of the fixed assets is not in excess of the recoverable amount of these assets.

(d) Employee Benefits

Provision is made in respect of the organisation's liability for annual leave and long service leave at balance date. Long service leave is accrued in respect of all employees with more than ten years service.

Contributions are made by the organization to an employee superannuation fund and are charged as expenses when incurred. The organization has no legal obligation to provide benefits to employees on retirement.

NOTE 2:INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED TO MEMBERS OR REGISTRAR In accordance with the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, the attention of members is drawn to the provisions of Sub-section (1), (2) and (3) of section 274, which read as follows:

- A member of an organization, or a Registrar, may apply to the organization for specified prescribed information in relation to the organization.
- 2) An organization shall on application made under Sub-section (1) by a member of the organization or Registrar, make the specified information available to the member or Registrar in such a manner, and within such time, as is prescribed.
- 3) A Registrar may only make an application under Sub-section (1) at the request of a member of the organization concerned, and the Registrar shall provide to a member information received because of an application made at the request of the member.

NOTE 3: OPERATING ACTIVITIES

In accordance with a resolution of the Committee, the activities of the Universities Staff Association of South Australia – Flinders Branch (USASA) were transferred to National Tertiary Education Industry Union – Flinders University Branch.

All assets, (with the exception of its cash reserves) and its liabilities were also transferred as at this date. The organization has also adopted the same accounting policies used by USASA.
