Dear Ms Kelly,

Re: Section 271 application for exemption from the financial reporting obligations of Part 3 of Chapter 8 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 for financial years ended 30 June 2006 (FR2006/278), 2007 (FR2007/328), 2008 (FR2008/408) and 2009 (FR2009/10117)*

I refer to your letter of 13 April 2011 addressed to 'The Registrar' Fair Work Australia. The letter was received at Fair Work Australia on 5 May 2011.

In the correspondence you make application 'at the request of and on behalf of' the Australian Film Television and Radio School Branch (the Branch). I note that in support of the application you state that 'the Branch held no funds prescribed under sub rule 51.4 of the NTEU Rules (as the rule was in force until December 2007) or under Schedule G, Section 12(b)', that 'members paid their union dues to the NSW Division or the National Office' and a statement that 'on and from 30 June 2008 by force of Schedule G section 3(a), it is not possible for any Branch of the NTEU to have financial affairs'.

I am satisfied that the Branch is a reporting unit and that it did not have any financial affairs in the years ended 30 June 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009. The attached certificate reflects this decision.

I grant an extension of time for the making of the application(s). I do so, on the basis of the particular circumstances of this application.

I take this opportunity to remind you of the import of reporting units strictly complying with each aspect of the legislative reporting requirements under the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*, the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009* and the Reporting Guidelines.

I advise the organisation that future applications must be made within 90 days after the end of the financial year.



Section 271- Application for Certificate

In consideration of Section 271 of the Act I apply for a certificate to exempt the Branch from the requirements of the ACT relating to financial matters occurring in the year ending 30th June 2006, 2007,2008 and 2009.

In support of the application I state:

- 1. The Branch does not hold an interest in any real or personal property
- 2. The Branch does not act as a trustee in any form
- 3. The Branch held no funds prescribed under sub rule 51.4 of the NTEU Rules (as that rule was in force until December 2007) or under Schedule G, Section 12(b).
