



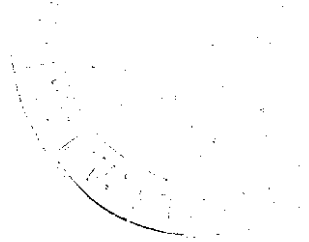



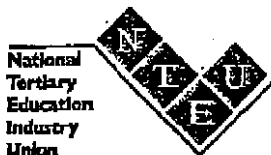
On 12 August 2002, the abovenamed organisation lodged in the Industrial Registry the prescribed information in relation to an election for the following office:

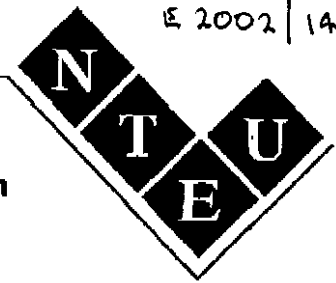

Request for Further Supplementary Election at the University of Melbourne branch

Further to the request in July, the NTEU now requests that a supplementary election be conducted for the position of **NATIONAL COUNCILLOR (elected by and from GENERAL STAFF)**

The position is unusual because both candidates were also candidates for the contested position of NATIONAL COUNCILLOR (elected by all members) and were successful in that election, thereby leaving the above position vacant.

The number required is ONE.

The position is elected by GENERAL STAFF MEMBERS.

The method of election is DIRECT.
