# Re: Schedule 1 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996 (the RAO Schedule) Financial Reports for year ended 30 June 2006 – FR2006/292

Reference is made to the financial reports of the National Tertiary, Education, and Industry Union – University of New England Branch for the year ended 30 June 2006. The documents were lodged in the Industrial Registry on 5 April 2007.

The financial documents have not been filed due to a defect.

I direct your attention to the following comments concerning the above reports and the financial reporting obligations under Schedule 1. Please note that these matters are advised for assistance in the future preparation of financial reports, no further action is required except for item 1.

# 1. <u>Certificate of Secretary or other authorised officer</u>

The certificate suggests the documents were "provided to members on 5<sup>th</sup> March 2007" and that the full report was presented to a meeting of the Committee of Management of the reporting unit on "14<sup>th</sup> February 2007". First, subsection 266(3) of Schedule 1 only permits the presentation of the full report to a committee of management meeting if the rules of the reporting unit provide for a specified percentage (not exceeding 5%) of members to be able to call a general meeting for the purpose of considering the report. Whilst the rules of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union make such provision with respect to the National office and the various Divisions, there is no like provision with respect to Branches of the organisation. This office has previously advised you of this in correspondence dated 9 February 2006. Secondly, it appears from the certificate the full report was provided to members after the meeting at which the report was presented. <u>Could you please resend your certificate of secretary with consistent dates by 26 April 2007 please.</u>

# 2. Committee of Management statement

The Committee of Management statement omitted to provide the date of resolution as required by item 26(b) of the Industrial Registrars reporting guidelines. Could you please ensure that this date is provided in future financial reports.

# 3. <u>Operating Report</u>

## Significant changes to financial affairs

Section 254(2)(b) of Schedule 1 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996 (RAO Schedule) provides that the operating report must give details of any significant changes in the reporting unit's financial affairs during the year. If there are no significant changes, a statement to that effect should be included. I note this was brought to the branches attention in out letter dated 20 December 2006. #### Operating Report For the Year Ended 30 June 2006

In accordance with Section 254 of the workplace Relations Act 1996 ("the Act"), your Committee of Management reports as follows:

## Principal Activities

The principal activity of the Branch during the year was that of a registered trade union. No significant change occurred in the nature of those activities during the year.

## **Operating Result**

The operating result of the Branch for the year ended 30 June 2006 was a deficit of \$2,085 (2005 surplus: \$11,677). No provision for tax was necessary as the Branch is considered exempt.

#### Significant Changes

There was no significant change in the financial affairs of the Branch during the year.

#### **Rights of Members**

In accordance with Section 174 of the Act, members have the right to resign their membership under the NTEU Rules as follows:

- 11.1 A member may resign from membership by written notice addressed and delivered to the member's Division Secretary or Branch Secretary provided that:
  - (a) Where a written notice of resignation is received by a Division Secretary he or she shall as soon as practicable forward a copy of the notice of resignation to the appropriate Branch Secretary; and
  - (b) Where a written notice of resignation is received by a Branch Secretary he or she shall as soon as practicable forward a copy of the notice of resignation to the relevant Division Secretary.

# 1. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

This financial report is a general purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the financial report preparation requirements of the members and the Workplace Relations Act 1996 and NSW Industrial Relations Act 1996.

The financial report is a general purpose financial report, which has been prepared in accordance with Accounting Standards, Urgent Issues Group Consensus Views, other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board and the Corporations Act 2001.

The financial report has been prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historical costs unless otherwise stated.

The financial report complies with certain Australian accounting standards, which include Australian equivalents to International Financial reporting Standards ("AIFRS"). Compliance with AIFRS ensures that the financial report, comprising the financial statements and notes thereto, complies with International Financial Reporting Standards ("IFRS").

This is the first financial report prepared based on AIFRS and comparatives for the year ended 30 June 2005 have been restated accordingly. As there was no adjustment in reported results when the Union moved to AIFRS there is no need to for a reconciliation of AIFRS equity and profit for 30 June 2006 to the balances reported in the 30 June 2005 financial report.

## (a) Information to be provided to members or Registrar

In accordance with requirements of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, a member of the Union, or a Registrar, may apply to the Union for specified prescribed information in relation to the organisation.

The Union shall, on application made by a member of the organisation or a Registrar, make the specific information available to the member or Registrar in such manner, and within such time, as is prescribed.

A Registrar may only make an application at the request of a member of the organisation concerned, and the Registrar shall provide to a member information received because of an application made at the request of the member.

# (b) **Provision for Employee Entitlements**

Provision has been made in the financial report for the Union's liability for accrued annual leave and long service leave arising from services rendered by employees to balance date. The assessment of probability of payment, calculation of net present values and inclusion of on-costs have not been included in the provisions as the Management Committee believes the adjustment would not be material to the financial report.

# Notes to the Financial Report For the Year Ended 30 June 2006 (continued)

#### (c) Income Tax

No provision has been made in the financial report for income tax on the basis that the Union is exempt under Section 50-15 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997 (formerly Section 23(f) of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1936).

#### (d) Fixed Assets

Fixed assets are stated in the financial report at historical cost less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation.

## (e) Contingent Liabilities

The members of the Committee of Management are unaware of any contingent liability, the effect of which may be material in relation to the financial report.

#### (f) Events Subsequent to Balance Date

No event has arisen subsequent to balance date, the effect of which may be material in relation to the financial report.

#### (f) Economic Dependency

The Union derives all of its capitation fee revenue from the University of New England or its related entities.
