Re: Financial documents for year ended 30 June 2003 FR 2003/445

Reference is made to the financial documents of the University of New South Wales Branch of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union for the year ended 30 June 2003 which were lodged in the Industrial Registry on 1 March 2004.

The financial documents have been filed.

The following matters are referred for assistance when preparing future financial documents; no further action is requested in respect of these:

1. Auditor's Report

The auditor in his report is required to give an opinion in respect of accounts and statements prepared in accordance with section 273 of the Act; such accounts include the certificates of the accounting officer and the committee of management.

The dates of the certificates supplied in respect of your Branch would indicate preparation after the auditor made his report.

Would you please bring this matter to your auditor's attention.

2. Comparative Figures

Section 273(1)(b) of the Act requires that an organisation include in the financial accounts the relevant figures from the accounts prepared by the organisation in relation to the preceding financial year.

I note that comparative figures have not been provided on this occasion.

Would you please bring this matter to the attention of your auditor.

3. Prescribed Information Notice

The notice included in the accounts drawing attention to provisions of the Act that prescribed information is available to members on request has set out the provisions of subsections (1) and (2) of section 512 of the Industrial Relations Act 1991.

The prescribed information notice should have set out the requirements of subsections 274(1), (2) and (3) of the Workplace Relations Act 1996.

4. Timescale provisions

The financial documents should have been lodged in the Industrial Registry within 14 days of the meeting at which they were presented - refer subsection 280(1).

The Registration and Accountability of Organisations Schedule (Schedule 1B to the Workplace Relations Act 1996) alters the arrangements under which organisations are required to provide financial and other information to members and the Industrial Registrar. Future financial returns will be required to meet the requirements of Schedule 1B. Your organisation has been provided with documentation in relation to the new requirements. You may wish to refer to section 269 of Schedule 1B which provides for reduced reporting requirements if a reporting unit has substantial common membership with a State registered body.

Documents on website

The Registry has created an electronic file for each registered organisation and branch which is accessible through the AIRC web site. The documents lodged have been placed on the AIRC Website at www.e-airc.gov.au/283vnsw. In light of the readier access which this will give to these documents, elected office bearers may wish to consider providing their work postal address (rather than their residential address) in the list of office bearers which is required to be lodged each year under RAO sections 233(1)(b) and (2).

Electronic lodgment

I encourage you to take advantage of the electronic lodgment service provided by the Registry for future lodgments. You may register as a user and then lodge your documents via the <u>Electronic Lodgment</u> page of the AIRC website at <u>www.airc.gov.au</u>. Alternatively, you may send an email with the documents attached to: <u>RIATeam3@air.gov.au</u>. Please note that the Rules of the Commission allow for electronic signatures to be used, other than for statutory declarations (see subrule 74A(1)). Where documents are lodged electronically, there will be no need to forward hard copies of the documents.


