1. Operating Report

Section 254(2)(c) of the RAO Schedule states:

Section 174(1) of the RAO Schedule states:

"A member of an organisation may resign from membership by written notice addressed and delivered to a person designated for the purpose in the rules of the organisation or a branch of the organisation."

2. General Purpose Financial Report

(a) Notes to Accounts

The accounts must contain a notice drawing the attention of the members to provisions of the RAO Schedule that prescribed information is available to them on request. Subsection 272(5) of the RAO Schedule requires the GPFR to set out subsections 272(1), (2) and (3). Would you please ensure those subsections are copied in to the GPFR in the next financial report of the Branch.

3. Insufficient time before documents presented to meeting

Financial reports should be prepared, audited, supplied to members, presented to a meeting and lodged in the Industrial Registry within certain timescale requirements. From the information available, the reports were audited on 25 November 2004 and presented to a meeting on 26 November 2004. We also note the Committee of Management Statement was dated on 8 December 2004. Therefore, it would appear that it is not possible the reports were provided to members at least 21 days before the meeting (refer to s265(5)(a) of the RAO Schedule).
