I acknowledge receipt of the financial reports of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union – University of New South Wales Branch for the year ended 30 June 2005 and the subsequent correspondences dated 19 June and 8 August 2006 containing the amended Committee of Management Statement, the Secretary's or Designated Officer's Certificate and the Auditor's Report. The documents were lodged in the Industrial Registry on 17 February, 28 June and 15 August 2006 respectively.

The documents have been filed.

Although the documents have been filed, I like to make some comments in addition to the comments contained in our correspondence dated 24 May 2006 (copy enclosed). I make these comments to assist you when you next prepare the financial reports. You *do not* need to take any further action in respect of the financial reports already lodged.

Committee of Management Statement

The requirements of the Committee of Management Statement are set out under the Industrial Registrar's Reporting Guidelines. In particular, Item 25 of the Reporting Guidelines requires the Committee of Management statement to declare, amongst other things:

During the financial year to which the GPFR relates and since the end of that year:

- where the organisation consists of 2 or more reporting units, the financial records of the reporting unit have been kept, as far as practicable, in a consistent manner to each of the other reporting units of the organisation; and
- the information sought in any request of a member of the reporting unit or a Registrar duly made under section 272 of the RAO Schedule has been furnished to the member or Registrar; and
- there has been compliance with any order for inspection of financial records made by the Commission under section 273 of the RAO Schedule.

The Committee of Management Statement for the year ended 30 June 2005 did not address the abovementioned matters. In the event that no request for information was sought by a member or Registrar under section 272 and/or no inspection of financial records was made by the Commission under section 273 a declaration to that effect is still required.

Operating Report

The requirements of the Operating Report are found under section 254 of the RAO Schedule and Regulation 159(c) of the RAO Regulations. Regulation 159(c) require the name of each person who has been a member of the Committee of Management of the branch at any time during the reporting period, *and* the period for which he or she held such a position be provided. In the Operating Report for the year ended 30 June 2005 only the former part of this requirement was met.

Auditor's Report

In future financial years the Auditor's Report should provide *details of the Auditor's qualifications* to confirm he or she is an approved auditor under s.256 of RAO Schedule and Regulation 4 of the RAO Regulations.

Regulation 4 defines an approved auditor as a person who is a member of CPA Australia, The Institute of Chartered Accountants in Australia or the National Institute of Accountants *and* holds a current Public Practice Certificate. The individual auditor signing off on the report should provide details of which professional body he or she is a member of and whether he or she holds a current Public Practice Certificate.

Please forward a copy of this letter to the reporting unit's auditor, Palmers Willoughby & Dunne.

I also note in my previous correspondence to you dated 14 September 2006 the letter should have been dated 7 September 2006. I apologise for any inconvenience caused.

Re: Financial Reports for year ended 30 June 2005 – National Tertiary Education Industry Union – University of New South Wales Branch – FR2005/374

I have received the financial reports of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union UNSW Branch for the year ended 30 June 2005. The documents were lodged in the Industrial Registry on 17 February 2006.

The documents have not yet been filed.

The NTEU – University of NSW Branch is required to further lodge:

- a revised Committee of Management Statement;
- a revised Secretary's Certificate; and
- a revised Auditor's Report.

The explanations to the deficiencies in the documents are set out below.

1. <u>Committee of Management Statement</u>

The Committee of Management Statement has failed to specify the *date* of passage of the resolution. (Please see item 26(b) of the Reporting Guideline for the purposes of s.253 of the RAO Schedule).

2. <u>Secretary's Certificate</u>

The Secretary's Certificate has failed to specify the *date* the full report was provided to its members and the *date* the full report was presented to a general meeting of members of the Branch. Please note, s.265(5) of the RAO Schedule requires that the full report must be provided to members 21 days before the general meeting.

3. <u>Auditor's Report</u>

The wording of the Auditor's Report must comply with s.257 of the RAO Schedule. The current Auditor's Report prepared by *Palmers Willoughby & Dunne* has failed to confirm whether the General Purpose Financial Report was presented fairly in accordance with the *Australian Accounting Standards*.

Moreover, the Auditor's Report refers to 'other statements prepared under section 273 of the *Workplace Relations Act 1996*'. Section 273 refers to Commission orders authorising applicants to inspect financial records. This reference to the RAO Schedule is made in error. None of the financial documents submitted were prepared pursuant to s.273.

The following wording would satisfy the requirements of the RAO Schedule:

"In our opinion the general purpose financial report is presented fairly in accordance with applicable Australian Accounting Standards and the requirements imposed by Part 3 of Chapter 8 of Schedule 1 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996."

Please draw this to the attention of your auditor for a revised version of the Auditor's Report.

These revised documents should be forwarded to the Registry as soon as practicable to facilitate the prompt filing of the NTEU – University of NSW Branch Financial Report for the year ended 30 June 2005.

Furthermore, it has been noted that the NTEU – University of NSW Branch Financial Report for the year ended 30 June 2004 have yet to be filed. The Secretary's Certificate for the year ended 30 June 2004 remains outstanding. Please find enclosed a copy letter dated 15 February 2005 from the Registry regarding this matter. Your prompt response in providing the Secretary's Certificate will facilitate in the filing of last year's Financial Reports.

1 Statement of Significant Accounting Policies

This financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared for use by directors and members of the company. The directors have determined that the company is not a reporting entity.

The financial report has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the following Australian Accounting Standards:

In accordance with section 254 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, the Committee of Management present the operating report for the year ended 30 June 2005.

Principal Activities

The principal activity of the Entity was the operation of the Branch of the Union and to provide a range of services to members.

Financial Results

The surplus from operating activities for the year was \$60,077.85 (2004 surplus \$28,424). The Union is exempt from paying income tax.

Review of Operations

The result represents a favourable variance of \$31,653.85 in comparison to last year. The result for the year was considered satisfactory.

Significant Changes

No significant changes in the state of affairs of the company have occurred during the financial year.

Rights of Members to Resign

- i. A member may resign from membership by written notice addressed and delivered to the member's Division Secretary or Branch Secretary provided that:
 - (a) Where a written notice of resignation is received by a Division Secretary he or she shall as soon as practicable forward a copy of the notice of resignation to the appropriate Branch Secretary;
 - (b) Where a written notice of resignation is received by a Branch Secretary he or she shall as soon as practicable forward a copy of the notice of resignation to the relevant Division Secretary.

- ii. A notice of resignation from membership takes effect:
 - where the member ceases to be eligible to become a member of the Union (a)
 - (i) on the day on which the notice is received by the Union; or
 - (ii) on the day specified in the notice, which is a day not earlier than the day when the member ceases to be eligible to become a member;

whichever is later; or

- **(b)** in any other case:
 - at the end of two weeks, or if permitted by law three months after the notice (i) is received by the Union; or
 - (ii) on the day specified in the notice;

whichever is later.

- iii. Any dues payable but not paid by a former member in relation to a period before the member's resignation took effect, may be sued for and recovered in the name of the Union in a court of competent jurisdiction, as a debt due to the Union.
- A notice delivered to a Division Secretary or Branch Secretary shall be taken to have been iv. received by the Union when it was delivered.
- A notice of resignation that has been received by the Union is not invalid because it was not v. addressed and delivered in accordance with sub-rule 1 of this rule.
- A resignation from membership is valid even if it is not affected in accordance with this rule vi. if the member is informed in writing by or on behalf of the Union that the resignation has been accepted.
- vii. Cessation of payment of any dues, levies and other amounts by a member does not, of itself, terminate membership of the Union.
