The following matter concerning the financial reporting requirements of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, requires your further attention:

1. Secretary's Certificate

It is noted that this matter was brought to the branch's attention with its financial documents for the periods ending 30 June 2000 and 30 June 2001 - refer to our letters of 20 July 2001 and 3 December 2002.

3. Time scale provisions

I note that the financial statements of the Branch have been lodged outside the time scales prescribed by the Workplace Relations Act 1996. Would you please ensure that financial statements for year ended 30 June 2003 are lodged within the abovementioned time scale provisions.

NOTE 1. STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with Statements of Accounting Concepts, applicable Accounting Standards and the Australian Workplace Relations Act, 1996. The accounts have been prepared on the basis of historical costs and do not take into account, changing money values or except where stated, current valuations of non current assets. The accounting policies have been consistently applied.

(a) Income Tax

No liability exists for income tax as the Association is exempt from income tax under section 50-15 of the Income Tax Assessment Act.

NOTE 2. INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED TO MEMBERS OR REGISTRAR

In accordance with the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act, 1996, the attention of members is drawn to the provisions of Sub-Sections (1), (2) and (3) of Section 274 which read as follows:

- (1) A member of an organization, or a Registrar, may apply to the organization for specified prescribed information in relation to the organization.
- (2) An organization shall, on application made under Sub-Section (1) by a member of the organization or a Registrar, make the specified information available to the member or Registrar in such manner, and within such time, as is prescribed.
- (3) A Registrar may only make an application under Sub-Section (1) at the request of a member of the organization concerned, and the Registrar shall provide to a member information received because of an application made at the request of the member.

Scope

We have audited the financial accounts of the National Tertiary Education Union Q.U.T. Branch for the year ended 30 June 2002 as set out on pages 1 to 5. the Union's Committee of Management and Accounting Officer are responsible for the preparation and presentation of the financial accounts and the information they contain. We have conducted an independent audit of these financial accounts in order to express an opinion on them to the members of the Union.

Our audit has been conducted in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards to provide reasonable assurance as to whether the financial accounts are free of material misstatement.
