NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL ACCOUNTS YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2003

NOTE 1. STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with Statements of Accounting Concepts, applicable Accounting Standards and the Australian Workplace Relations Act, 1996. The accounts have been prepared on the basis of historical costs and do not take into account, changing money values or except where stated, current valuations of non current assets. The accounting policies have been consistently applied.

(a) Income Tax

No liability exists for income tax as the Association is exempt from income tax under section 50-15 of the Income Tax Assessment Act.

NOTE 2. INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED TO MEMBERS OR REGISTRAR

In accordance with the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act, 1996, the attention of members is drawn to the provisions of Sub-Sections (1), (2) and (3) of Section 274 which read as follows:

- (1) A member of an organization, or a Registrar, may apply to the organization for specified prescribed information in relation to the organization.

To the members of the National Tertiary Education Union

Scope

We have audited the financial accounts of the National Tertiary Education Union Q.U.T. Branch for the year ended 30 June 2003 as set out on pages 1 to 5. the Union's Committee of Management and Accounting Officer are responsible for the preparation and presentation of the financial accounts and the information they contain. We have conducted an independent audit of these financial accounts in order to express an opinion on them to the members of the Union.

Our audit has been conducted in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards to provide reasonable assurance as to whether the financial accounts are free of material misstatement.
