



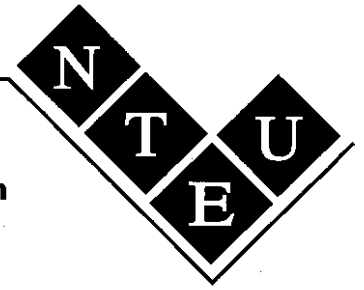

**NATIONAL TERTIARY EDUCATION INDUSTRY UNION - REQUEST FOR ELECTIONS
TO BE HELD.**

I, **GRAHAME McCULLOCH**, General Secretary of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union, hereby request, pursuant to Section 214 of the Act, that the Registrar arrange for the further conduct of this organisation's elections in 2001, and state as follows:

1. Elections are required for those positions specified in the attached table, Attachment A.
2.
 - (a) **The name of each office** (61(1)(a)) is specified in the first and second columns of Attachment A.
 - (b) **The reason for the election** (61(1)(b)) is as specified in the fifth column of Attachment A, according to the Key to Election Request which is at Attachment B.
 - (c) **The electorate from which each office is to be elected** is as indicated in the fourth column of Attachment A, headed "Elected By", read in conjunction with Attachment B (61(1)(d)).
 - (d) **The voting system to be employed** in the conduct of the election is as indicated in the sixth column of Attachment A read in conjunction with Attachment B (61(1)(c)).
 - (e) The period during which nominations may be called is such that no time is prescribed by the rules in relation to these elections.
3. The terms of office for each position in the attached table is two years, ending on 1 October 2002.
4. In respect of the positions indicated in "Attachment A" this request arises because an election has already been conducted but no nominations were received.
