NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE 2003

1. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

This financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared in order to satisfy the Trustees' accountability requirements under the Unions' Rules and the requirements under the Workplace Relations Act 1996 to prepare a financial report. The Trustees' have determined that the Branch is not a reporting entity.

The financial report has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, and the following applicable Accounting Standards.

AAS 3 Income Tax

AAS 4 Depreciation

AAS 5 Materiality

AAS 8 Events Occurring After Reporting Date

No other applicable Accounting Standards, Urgent Issues Group Consensus Views or other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board have been applied.

The financial report is also prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historic costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following material accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this financial report:

(a) Plant & Equipment

Depreciation is provided on all fixed assets so as to write off the assets progressively over their estimated economic lives to the Branch. The prime cost method of depreciation is used.

(b) Provision for Employee Entitlements

The provision relates to annual leave and long service leave and has been calculated on the basis of actual entitlements under appropriate awards, based on current wage rates.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE 2003

1. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (cont'd)

(c) Income Tax

No income tax has been provided, as the Branch is exempt from income tax pursuant to Section 50-15 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.

(d) Information to be provided to members or registrar

In accordance with the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, as amended, the attention of members is drawn to the provisions of sub-section (1) (2) and (3) of section 274, which reads as follows:

- (1) A member of an organisation or Registrar may apply to the organisation for specified prescribed information in relation to the organisation.
- (2) An Organisation shall, on application made under subsection (1) by members of the organisation or a Registrar, make the specified information available to the member or Registrar in such manner, and within such time as prescribed.
- (3) A Registrar may only make an application under sub-section (1) at the request of a member of the organisation concerned, and the Registrar shall provide to a member information received because of an application made at the request of the members.

Scope

We have audited the attached financial statements, being a special purpose financial report set out on pages 1 to 8 of the National Tertiary Education Union – Swinburne University of Technology Branch for the year ended 30^{th} June 2003. The Union's Branch Executive is responsible for the financial statements and has determined that the accounting policies used and described in Note 1 to the financial statements which form part of the financial report are appropriate to meet the needs of the Workplace Relations Act and are appropriate to meet the needs of the members. We have conducted an independent audit of these financial statements in order to express an opinion on them to the members of the National Tertiary Education Union – Swinburne University of Technology Branch. No opinion is expressed as to whether the accounting policies used are appropriate to the needs of the members.

The financial statements have been prepared for the purpose of fulfilling the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act. We disclaim any assumption of reliance on this report or on the financial statements to which it relates to any person other than the members or for any purpose other than that for which it was prepared.

These procedures have been undertaken to form an opinion as to whether, in all material respects, the financial report is presented fairly in accordance with the accounting policies described in Note 1 so as to present a view which is consistent with our understanding of the Branch's financial position, and performance as represented by the results of its operations. These policies do not require the application of all Accounting Standards and other mandatory professional reporting requirements in Australia.

The audit opinion expressed in this report has been formed on the above basis.

Reference is made to the financial documents of the Swinburne University of Technology Branche and a standard of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union for the year ended 30 June 2003 which were try of a standard lodged in the Industrial Registry on 23 January 2004.

The financial documents have been filed.

The following matters are referred for assistance when preparing future financial documents; no further action is requested in respect of these:

1. Secretary's certificate

Subsection 279(6) requires that members should be supplied with a copy of each of the (signed and dated) auditor's report, committee of management certificate and accounting officer's certificate, together with a copy of the audited accounts at least 7 days before the meeting at which the report, certificates and accounts are to be presented. Subsection 279(6) also provides that once the report, certificates and accounts have been supplied to members they are to be presented to either a meeting of members or a meeting of the committee of management.

I note that your Secretary's certificate indicates that the financial documents were presented to the Branch Annual General meeting on 9 December 2003.

Given that the auditor's report is dated 16 December 2003, it would appear that such document presented to the Branch Annual General meeting on 9 December 2003 was neither signed nor dated.

Would you please ensure in future when supplying members with financial documents and also when presenting such documents to a meeting as required by subsection 279(6) of the Act that such documents are signed and dated.

2. Dating of Certificates

It is noted that the accounting officer's and committee of management certificates are dated December 2003.

All certificates should provide the full date of signature as a matter of course.

3. Timescale Provisions

Unless an extension is granted, financial documents should be lodged in the Industrial Registry within 14 days of the meeting at which they were presented - refer subsection 280(1).

The Registration and Accountability of Organisations Schedule (Schedule 1B to the Workplace Relations Act 1996) alters the arrangements under which organisations are required to provide financial and other information to members and the Industrial Registrar. Future financial returns will be required to meet the requirements of Schedule 1B. Your organisation has been provided with documentation in relation to the new requirements.
