Financial Reporting Obligations - Workplace Relations Act 1996

This is a courtesy letter to remind you of the financial reporting obligations of the abovenamed body, arising under Part IX, Division 11 of the *Workplace Relations Act* 1996 ('the Act') in respect of financial year ended 30 June 2001.

An organisation registered under the Act or a branch of such an organisation is required to carry out the various steps of the financial reporting obligations within certain time-scales. Now that the financial year has ended, it is timely that you now consider and implement the following steps within those timescales:-

- preparation of the financial statements
- commencement of the audit of the accounting records
- consideration of the financial statements and passage of a resolution by the committee of management in relation to certain matters concerning the statements
- preparation of the certificates by the accounting officer and the committee of management
- receipt of the auditor's report
- provision of copies of the auditor's report, accounts and statements to the members
- following provision of copies to the members, presentation of the auditor's report, accounts and statements to a meeting of the members or the committee of management
- lodgement of copies of the auditor's report, accounts and statements in the Industrial Registry accompanied by your certificate confirming that the documents so lodged are copies of those presented to the meeting following provision of copies to members - the certificate should specify the type of meeting and the date when the meeting was held

The obligation to provide documents to members may be discharged by provision of a summary subject to certain conditions.

I have enclosed for your information a notice describing the financial reporting requirements in more detail, including the time-scales prescribed by the legislation.

Please note that a branch of an organisation may be exempted from the obligations arising under Part IX, Division 11 in respect of a financial year by satisfying a Registrar that the branch did not have any financial affairs during the financial year. An application under subsection 271A(1) of the Act must be made within 90 days (unless extended by a Registrar) after the end of the financial year. In the case of the financial year which ended on 30 June 2001, such an application should be made by a branch before 30 September 2001.

I invite you to contact me on (03) 8661 7787 if you wish to discuss the financial reporting requirements. Should you anticipate any difficulty in meeting any step in the time-scale prescribed you may wish to note that the legislation allows for an extension of time to be sought in certain circumstances.

Re: Financial returns for years ended 30 June 2000 and 30 June 2001 FR 2002/13 and 14

Reference is made to the financial documents of the Central Queensland University Branch of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union for the years ended 30 June 2000 and 30 June 2001 The documents were lodged in the Industrial Registry on 8 January 2002.

Examination of the financial documents for the year ended 30 June 2000 has shown that matters requiring advice have either been corrected or repeated in relation to the Branch's financial documents for the year ended 30 June 2001.

The following matter in relation to the financial documents for the financial years 30 June 2000 and 30 June 2001 concerning the financial reporting requirements of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, requires your further attention; your written response to this matter is requested by Monday, 25 February 2002

1. Auditor's Report

Subsection 276(4) of the Act requires an auditor to state, whether in the auditor's opinion:

- "(a)(i) there were kept by the organisation in relation to the year satisfactory accounting records, including:
 - (A) records of the sources and nature of the income of the organisation (including income from members); and
 - (B) records of the nature and purposes of the expenditure of the organisation; and
 - (ii) the accounts and statements prepared under section 273 in relation to the year were properly drawn up so as to give a true and fair view of:
 - (A) the financial affairs of the organisation as at the end of the year; and
 - (B) the income and expenditure, and any surplus or deficit, of the organisation for the year; and
- (b) whether all the information and explanations that, under subsection (2), officers or employees of the organisation were required to provide were provided;

and, in addition, the auditor shall state in the report particulars of any deficiency, failure or shortcoming in relation to a matter referred to in paragraph (a) or (b)."

The auditor's reports do not provide the above statements.

Would you please bring this matter to the attention of the auditor and request the auditor to forward to this office amended auditor's reports.

The following matters in relation to the year ended 30 June 2001 are referred for assistance when preparing future financial documents; no further action is requested in respect of these:

2. Dating of Certificates/Reports

It is noted that the accounting officer's and committee of management certificates are undated.

All certificates should be dated as a matter of course.

As the date of the auditor's report sets in train the timescales in which the financial documents are to be distributed to members, presented to a meeting and lodged with the Registrar it is an essential element of the report.

Would you please ensure in future that all certificates and the auditor's report are dated.

3. Committee of Management Certificate

The committee of management certificate was not completed correctly.

The committee of management should have provided a statement to the effect that the organisation has complied with subsection 279(1) and (6) of the Act in relation to the financial accounts in respect of the year ended 30 June 2000, and the auditor's report thereon.

It should be noted that this part of the committee of management's certificate always refers back to the preceding year.

4. Auditor's Report

It is not clear who the signatory to the auditor's report is.

Also, the signatory of the auditor's report has not indicated whether he is registered as a company auditor - refer regulation 112.

It is the attitude of this Office that the above should be evident to members in the published financial documents.

5. Prescribed information notice

There should be included in the accounts a notice drawing attention to provisions of the Act that prescribed information is available to members on request and which sets out a copy of subsections 274(1), (2) and (3) - refer subsection 274(4) of the Act.

6. Timescale Provisions

Unless an extension is granted, financial documents should be lodged in the Industrial Registry within 14 days of the meeting at which they were presented - refer subsection 280(1).

Outstanding financial returns

There is no record of the receipt in this Office of the financial documents of the Central Queensland University Branch in respect of the year ended 30 June 1999.

I note in your letter dated 11 September 2001 your advice that the financial documents for the year ended 30 June 1999 are being prepared. I also note Mr. verbal advice to Mr. Lapierre of this office on 11 September 2001 advising that the financial documents should be ready for auditing by the end of September 2001.

Your advice would be appreciated before Monday, 25 February 2002 as to when lodgement, under cover of your certification in accordance with subsection 280(1), may be expected.
