Dear General Manager

I write to inform you that the National Executive of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union, at its meeting on 12 February 2010, resolved as follows:

National Executive resolves to establish a Branch of the NTEU to be known as the University of Notre Dame Australia Branch ("UNDA"). The jurisdiction of the Branch is that it consists of all NTEU members whose primary employment within the NTEU Eligibility Rule is in or in connection with the UNDA.

Until the Branch otherwise decides or a change occurs pursuant to the rules, the UNDA Branch shall have a Branch Committee of the following composition: Branch President Branch Vice-President Branch Secretary and Ordinary Committee member (Indigenous).

That the Union advise the FWA Registry of the formation of the Branch and the creation of these offices, and request that an election be authorised to be conducted by the AEC.

The NTEU therefore advises Fair Work Australia, as required by the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act, that we have a new Branch on and from the date of the National Executive meeting.

Following this resolution, I have attached a request for elections to be held for the University of Notre Dame Australia Branch ("UNDA") under the Rules of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union (**Attachment A**). Rule 36.1 outlines the authority of the National Executive to determine the composition of a Branch Committee:


36.1 The business of the Branch shall be managed by a Branch Committee which shall consist of the Branch Officers as specified in Rule 35, the Indigenous Branch Committee Member(s) elected pursuant to Sub-Rule 18.3I or Sub-Rule 18.3J and such number of Ordinary Committee Members as the Branch in General Meeting may determine from time to time, provided that the total number of Branch Committee members, inclusive of Branch Officers, shall be not less than three.

Provided that:

(a) Until a first determination has been made by the Branch in General Meeting under this sub-rule, any general meeting of the Branch or a resolution of the National Executive or the relevant Division Executive may determine the number of Ordinary Committee Members.

Until decided otherwise by the Branch, the address for the University of Notre Dame Australia Branch is Level 1, 97 Broadway, Nedlands WA 6009, which is also the address of the NTEU Western Australian Division.

REQUEST FOR ELECTIONS TO BE HELD

I, Grahame McCulloch General Secretary of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union, hereby request, pursuant to Section 189 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act, that the General Manager arrange for the conduct of an election for the newly established University of Notre Dame Australia Branch.

1. Elections are required for those positions specified in the attached table, Attachment A.
2. (a) **The name of each office** (138(1)(a)) is specified in the first column of Attachment A.
 - (b) **The reason for the election** (138(1)(b)) is as specified in the fourth column of Attachment A, according to the "Key to Election Request".
 - (c) **Where more than one of the offices in respect of which an election is required have the same name** (138(1)(c)) the number of such offices is as specified in the second column of Attachment A, headed "No. Required".
 - (d) **The electorate from which each office is to be elected** (138(1)(d)) is as indicated in the third column of Attachment A, headed "Elected By", read in conjunction with the "Key to Election Request".
 - (e) **The voting system to be employed** (138(1)(g)) in the conduct of the election is as indicated in the fifth column of Attachment A, read in conjunction with the "Key to Election Request".
 - (f) **The period during which nominations may be called** (138(1)(e)) - no time is prescribed by the rules.
3. The terms of office for each position in the attached table is until 1 October 2010, or as otherwise provided in the rules.
4. **The date provided for in the rules as the day on which the roll of voters is to be closed** (138(1)(f)) is the seventh day before the date determined for the opening of nominations.
5. I certify that to the best of my knowledge and belief, the information is correct and based upon advice given by the relevant Branches and Divisions.
