This is a courtesy letter to remind you of the financial reporting obligations of the abovenamed body under the *Workplace Relations Act 1996* ('the Act') for the financial year ended 30 June, 2002.

The legislative scheme set out in Part IX, Division 11 of the Act is directed at ensuring that a registered organisation or a branch of such an organisation discharges obligations of accountability to its members in relation to its financial affairs through proper and regular disclosure of financial information. The various steps of the financial reporting requirements must be carried out within the time-scales prescribed by the legislation so as to ensure the relevance of the financial information provided to the members.

Now that the financial year has ended, it is timely that you put in train the various steps of the financial reporting requirements. To assist you with this process I have enclosed for your information a notice summarising these requirements including the time-scales prescribed by the legislation.

- "(1) A Member of an Organisation, or a Registrar, may apply to the Organisation for specified prescribed information in relation to the Organisation.
- (2) An Organisation shall, on application made under Sub-Section (1) by a Member of the Organisation or a Registrar, make the specified information available to the Member or Registrar in such manner, and within such time as is prescribed.
- (3) A Registrar may only make an application under Sub-Section (1) at the request of a Member of the Organisation concerned, and the Registrar shall provide to a Member information received because of an application made at the request of the Member."

An Organisation shall not contravene Section 274 (1), (2) and (3). Penalty \$1,000.

Certificates required to be given under the Act, by the Accounting Officer and the Branch Executive, have been completed in accordance with the provisions of the Act, and contain no qualifications.

The Auditors' Report on the Accounts did not contain any particulars of any deficiency, failure or shortcoming as referred to in the Workplace Relations Act, 1996.

### NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE ACCOUNTS For the Year Ended 30 June 2002

#### **NOTE 1 - ACCOUNTING METHODS**

The Accounts are prepared under the Historical Cost Convention and in accordance with the Accounting Standards jointly issued by the Australian Professional Accounting Bodies, and the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act, 1996. Contributions are accounted for on a Cash Basis. In particular:-

- (a) The Accounts have not been adjusted to record either changes in the general purchasing power of the dollar or in the prices of specific Assets.
- (b) Depreciation of Fixed Assets is provided for at rates considered appropriate to the lives of such Assets.
- (c) Provision for Employee Benefits in the form of Long Service Leave, Accrued Annual Leave, etc., have been made for the estimated accrued entitlements of all Employees on the basis of their terms of Employment.
- (d) No Provision for Income Tax is necessary as "Trade Unions" are exempt under Section 50-15 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.

#### NOTE 2 - INFORMATION TO BE PROVIDED TO MEMBERS OR REGISTRAR

In accordance with the requirements of the Workplace Relations Act, 1996, the attention of Members is drawn to the provisions of Sub-Sections (1), (2) and (3) of Section 274, which reads as follows:-

- "(1) A Member of an Organisation, or a Registrar, may apply to the Organisation for specified prescribed information in relation to the Organisation.
- (2) An Organisation shall, on application made under Sub-Section (1) by a Member of the Organisation or a Registrar, make the specified information available to the Member or Registrar in such manner, and within such time as is prescribed.
- (3) A Registrar may only make an application under Sub-Section (1) at the request of a Member of the Organisation concerned, and the Registrar shall provide to a Member information received because of an application made at the request of the Member."
