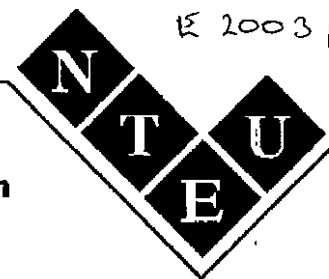

TO BE HELD.**

I, **GRAHAME MCCULLOCH**, General Secretary of the National Tertiary Education Industry Union, hereby request, pursuant to Section 214 of the Act, that the Registrar arrange for the conduct of elections, and state as follows:

1. Elections are required for those positions specified in the attached table, Attachment A.

  - (a) **The name of each office (61(1)(a))** is specified in the first and second columns of Attachment A.
  - (b) **The reason for the election (61(1)(b))** is as specified in the fourth column of Attachment A, according to the Key to Election Request which is at Attachment B.
  - (c) **The electorate from which each office is to be elected** is as indicated in the third column of Attachment A, headed "Elected By", read in conjunction with Attachment B (61(1)(d)).

  - (e) The period during which nominations may be called is within 3 months of the vacancy occurring, in accordance with Rule 80.4
