I refer to the above election for your organisation.

Section 197(1) of Schedule 1 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 requires the AEC to provide a written report on the conduct of the election to Fair Work Australia and to the organisation or branch for whom the election was conducted. 

In accordance with Rule 7(2)(b)(ii), the number of National Council delegates to which each Branch is entitled has been determined as:

The number of National Council delegate positions subject to election is reduced by one given that the first delegate for each Branch shall be the Branch Secretary in accordance with Rule 7(1)(e).

2. **The reason for the election is that the term of office will expire in the normal course of events. [Regulation 138 (1) (b) (i)]**
3. **Those offices or positions which have the same name and number of such offices or positions required to be determined appears at paragraph A.1 above. [Regulation 138 (1) (c)]**
4. **The electorates comprising only members of a branch, section or division of the organisation appears at paragraph A.1 above. [Regulation 138 (1) (d)]**
5. **The date and time of the beginning of the nomination period is the first week in May 2010 in accordance with Rule 13 (e) (5). In the past the AEC has held this to mean the first working day of May. Accordingly the date would be 3 May 2010. [Regulation 138 (1) (e)]**
6. **The date and time of the end of the nomination period is 12noon on the last Friday in May (i.e. 28 May 2010) in accordance with Rule 13 (e) (5). [Regulation 138 (1) (e)]**
7. **The day upon which the roll of voters closes is seven days prior to the opening of nominations in accordance with Rule 13 (e) (5). [Regulation 138 (1) (f)].**
8. **The kind of voting is direct voting (i.e. first past the post”). [Regulation 138 (1) (g)]**
