6. The date and time of the end of the nomination period is 12noon on the last Friday in May (i.e. 30 May 2014) in accordance with Rule 13 (e) (5). **[Regulation 138 (1) (e)]**

7. The day upon which the roll of voters closes is seven days prior to the opening of nominations in accordance with Rule 13 (e) (5).

8. The kind of voting is direct voting (i.e. first past the post”).
