Regulation 138 - Prescribed information for conduct of an election

PRESCRIBED INFORMATION FOR CONDUCT OF ELECTION IN RELATION TO A NEW OFFICE FOR WHICH AN ELECTION IS REQUIRED

- A. The following information is in relation to an election that is to be conducted by the Australian Electoral Commission ("AEC").
 - 1. The name of each office or position for which an election is required: [Regulation 138 (1) (a)]

General Branch	Assistant Secretary	1

- 2. The reason for the election is that the above office is a new office arising from the decision of the Delegate of the General Manager certifying alterations to the Rules of the organisation [2103] FWCD 5198. [Regulation 138 (1) (b) (iii)]
- 3. Regulation 138 (1) (c) does not apply to this application.
- 4. The electorate of the organisation appears at paragraph A.1 above. [Regulation 138 (1) (d)]
- 5. The organisation's Rules require that as far as practicable an election for a casual vacancy be conducted in a manner consistent with an ordinary election (Rules 13,16, 37F and 43)

On this basis the Union submits that the date and time of the beginning of the nomination period should be determined by the AEC acting as the returning officer, provided that the nomination period be open for a period of at least 28 days. [Regulation 138 (1) (e)]

- 6. The day upon which the roll of voters closes is seven days prior to the opening of nominations in accordance with Rule 13 (e) (5) and should be determined by the AEC. [Regulation 138 (1) (f)].
- 7. In accordance with Rule 13 (d), the kind of voting is direct voting. [Regulation 138 (1) (g)]
- 8. An indicative example of the key dates proposed to be determined by the AEC and associated with the conduct of the election appears as Attachment A hereto.
- B. A statement in accordance with Regulation 138 (2) is attached hereto.
