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NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE 2003

1. STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with Australian Accounting Standards including the disclosure requirements of the Workplace Relations Act 1996.

The following is a summary of significant accounting policies adopted by the Union in the preparation of the accounts which, unless otherwise stated, have been consistently applied:-

(a) Basis of Accounting

The accounts have been prepared on the basis of historical costs and do not take into account changing money values or, except where otherwise stated, current valuations of fixed assets.

With the exception of membership contributions, all income and expenditure of the Union has been brought to account on an accruals basis of accounting so as to match income for the period with the expenditure incurred in earning that income. This represents a change of accounting policy in relation to the IPP Property Trust distributions which were previously brought to account on a cash basis, and this has resulted in an amount of \$16,414 being included in the income of the Union for the year ended 30th June 2003.

Membership subscriptions are brought to account on the cash basis of accounting as and when received as permitted by Section 272 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996.

Distress Fund

The Union maintains a "Distress Fund" for the benefit of members of the Union. During the year, payments were made to members as loans and the balance owing in respect of the loans has been included as an asset in the Balance Sheet. A provision for doubtful debts in respect to the above loans has also been included.

(b) Provision for Employee Entitlements

Provision has been made in the financial statements for the Union's liability for accrued annual leave, long service leave and rostered days off in respect of all employees determined by reference to their respective period of service and terms of employment.

NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE 2003 (CONT'D)

(c) Income Tax

No provision has been made in the accounts for income tax on the basis that the Union is exempt under Section 50-15 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997 (formerly Section 23(f) of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1936).

(d) Fixed Assets

Fixed assets are stated in the accounts at historical cost less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation.

Fixed assets, other than Freehold Land & Leasehold Improvements, are depreciated on a diminishing value basis over the period of their estimated effective lives. Leasehold Improvements are amortised on a straight line basis.

- (3) A registrar may only make an application under sub-section (1) at the request of a member of the organisation concerned and the registrar shall provide to a member information received because of an application made at the request of the member.
