Re: Lodgement of Financial Statements and Accounts - National Union of Workers, Victorian Branch - for year ended 30 June 2013 (FR2013/376)

I refer to the financial report of the National Union of Workers, Victorian Branch (the reporting unit). The documents were lodged with the Fair Work Commission on 19 November 2013. An amended Designated Officer Certificate was lodged today.

The financial report has now been filed.

The financial report was filed based on a primary review. This involved confirming that the financial reporting timelines required under s.253, s.265, s.266 and s.268 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (RO Act) have been satisfied, all documents required under s.268 of the RO Act were lodged and that various disclosure requirements under the Australian Accounting Standards, RO Act and reporting guidelines have been complied with. A primary review does not examine all disclosure requirements.

Please note that the financial report for the year ending 30 June 2014 may be subject to an advanced compliance review.

I make the following comments to assist you when you next prepare a financial report. You are not required to take any further action in respect of the report lodged for 2013. The Fair Work Commission will confirm these matters have been addressed prior to filing next year's report.

Auditor's report: declaration regarding going concern

Paragraph 45 of the reporting guidelines requires an auditor to include in the auditor's statement a declaration that as part of the audit of the financial statement they have concluded that management's use of the going concern basis of accounting in the preparation of the reporting unit's financial statements is appropriate. This declaration was not included in the auditor's statements.

Disclosure of employee expenses/benefits to office holders and other employees

The financial statements have disclosed wages, superannuation, annual leave, long service leave and other employee expenses and provisions separately for officers and employees, but do not separately disclose separation/redundancy expenses or provisions. The Reporting Guidelines requires that all prescribed employee and officer benefits are reported separately (refer items 17(f) and 17(g), and 21(c) and 21(d)).

Items 18 and 22 of the Reporting Guidelines state that if any activities identified in items 17(f), 17(g), 21(c) and 21(d) have not occurred in the reporting period, a statement to this effect must

be included in the notes to the GPFR¹. I note that for separation/redundancy expenses or separation/redundancy provisions for officers and other employees no such statement has been made.

Item 16 of the Reporting Guidelines likewise states that if any activities identified in item 15 have not occurred in the reporting period, a statement to this effect must be included in the notes to the GPFR. I note that for capitation fee receipts (item 15(b)) from other reporting units no statement has been made, and that for financial support from (item 15(e)) or to (item 17(b)) other reporting units the names of each such reporting unit is not identified.

NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE 2013

1. STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial report is a general purpose financial report that has been prepared in accordance with Australian Accounting Standards including Australian Accounting Interpretations and the reporting and disclosure requirements of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009. The financial statements are presented in Australian dollars.

The following is a summary of the material accounting policies adopted by the Union in the preparation of the financial report which, unless otherwise stated, have been consistently applied:-

(a) Basis of Accounting

The financial report has been prepared on the basis of historical costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where otherwise stated, current valuations of fixed assets.

Change of Accounting Policy

All income and expenditure of the Union has been brought to account on an accruals basis of accounting so as to match income for the period with the expenditure incurred in earning that income. This is a change in accounting policy as membership subscriptions were previously brought to account on the cash basis of accounting. This has resulted in an additional \$701,935 of membership subscriptions for the current financial year.

Distress Fund

The Union maintains a "Distress Fund" for the benefit of members of the Union.

(b) Employee Leave Entitlements

Provision has been made in the financial report for the Union's liability for accrued annual leave, long service leave and rostered days off in respect of all employees determined by reference to their respective period of service and terms of employment.

(c) Income Tax

No provision has been made in the financial report for income tax on the basis that the Union is exempt under Section 50-15 of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.

NOTES TO AND FORMING PART OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE 2013 (CONT'D)

(d) Fixed Assets

Fixed assets are stated in the financial report at historical cost less, where applicable, any accumulated depreciation.

Fixed assets are depreciated on a straight line or diminishing value basis over the period of their estimated effective lives.

(e) Comparatives

Where necessary, comparative information has been reclassified to achieve consistency in disclosure with current financial year information and other disclosures.

(f) Goods & Services Tax (GST)

Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of GST, except where the amount of GST incurred is not recoverable from the Australian Taxation Office. In these circumstances the GST is recognised as part of the cost of acquisition of the assets or as part of the expense. Receivables and payables in the statement of financial position are shown inclusive of GST.

(g) Other Disclosure Requirements under Sec 253

There were no penalties imposed on the reporting unit under the Act or Regulations during the reporting period.

2. FAIR WORK (REGISTERED ORGANISATIONS) ACT 2009

In accordance with the requirements of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009, the attention of members is drawn to the provisions of sub-sections (1), (2) and (3) of section 272, which reads –

- (1) A member of a reporting unit, or the General Manager of FWA, may apply to the reporting unit for specified prescribed information in relation to the reporting unit to be made available to the person making the application.
- (2) The application must be in writing and must specify the period within which, and the manner in which, the information is to be made available. The period must not be less than 14 days after the application is given to the reporting unit.
- (3) A reporting unit must comply with an application made under subsection (1).

OPERATING REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE 2013

In accordance with sec 254 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009, your Committee of Management report as follows:

Principal Activities

The principal activities of the Union were to improve the wages and working conditions of its members. This was undertaken through bargaining with employers, maintaining the content of modern awards and by appearing before industrial tribunals, principally the Fair Work Commission.

During the reporting period the Union made submissions to a number of public enquiries and either launched or fostered campaigns around issues of importance to its members and working men and women generally.

Decisions of the Branch Committee of Management were implemented in furtherance of the above during the reporting period.

Operating Result

The operating result of the Branch for the year ended 30th June 2013 was a surplus of \$4,117,740. No provision for tax was necessary as the Branch is considered exempt.

The main reasons for the operating result are –

- Membership fees have increased due to the change in accounting policy which means membership fees are now accounted for on an accruals basis rather than cash basis
- Appreciation in the value of investments
- Recovery of a previous doubtful debt

Significant Changes

There was no significant change in the financial affairs of the Branch during the year.

This is a courtesy letter to remind you of the obligation to prepare and lodge the financial report for the reporting unit by the due date, namely 15 January 2014 (that is the period within 6 months and 14 days of the end of the financial year) under s.268 of the RO Act.

The RO Act sets out a particular chronological order in which financial documents and statements must be prepared, audited, provided to members and presented to a meeting. For your assistance, the attached *Timeline/Planner* summarises these requirements.

Fact sheets regarding financial reporting under the RO Act are provided on the Fair Work Commission website at: Financial Reporting Fact Sheets.

The documents can be emailed to orgs@fwc.gov.au. If it is envisaged that the financial report cannot be lodged by the due date you are requested to contact this office prior to the due date to discuss the issue.

It should be noted that s.268 is a civil penalty provision. Failure to lodge a financial report may result in legal proceedings being issued with the possibility of a pecuniary penalty (up to \$33,000 for a body corporate and \$6,600 for an individual per contravention) being imposed upon an officer whose conduct led to the contravention and/or your organisation.
