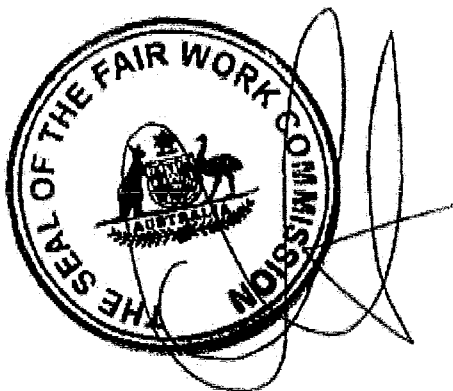

PRESCRIBED INFORMATION FOR THE CONDUCT OF AN ELECTION

Pursuant to Section 189(1) of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* and regulation 138 of the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulation*, The NSW Farmers' (Industrial) Association informs you of the following prescribed information:

Section 189(1):

- a) An election is required in respect of each of the following offices:

- b) The election is required as the term of office for each of the positions specified in (i) to (iv) will shortly expire.
- c) All members of the NSW Farmers' (Industrial) Association are eligible to vote.
- d) The next Annual General Meeting of members of the Association will be held at the Luna Park commencing at 9am on Tuesday, 15 July 2014, with elections scheduled for at or about 2pm, Thursday, 17 July 2014 to enable members present to nominate candidates for offices listed in a).

- e) The following rules of the Association apply to the elections:
- i. Rule 22(i) - Nomination – President, Vice President, Treasurer,
 - ii. Rule 23(ii) - Nomination – Executive Committee; and,
 - iii. Rule 36(i) - Nominations at Annual General Meeting) provide nominations of candidates for the offices referred to therein to be made at the Annual General Meeting.
- f) A direct voting system is to be employed in the conduct of election.
- g) The roll of voters shall close 7 days before the date of the Annual General Meeting pursuant to rule 39.

I am an officer of the Association duly authorised to make this statement pursuant to Section 138 of the Regulations.

I hereby request that the Registrar notify the Australian Electoral Commission of our forthcoming AGM and the requirement for them to conduct an election if necessary.
