In accordance with S214 of the Workplace Relations Act 1996 and Regulation 61 of the Regulations, nominations have recently been called by the Australian Electoral Commission ACT Branch for the election of six National Vice Presidents of the National Council of the Pharmacy Guild of Australia.

At the close of nominations on 9 September 2002 only five nominations had been received leaving a vacancy of one position viz the national Vice President representing the Tasmanian Branch. (See copy of the Returning Officer's report attached.)

Rule 55B(a)(ii) states inter-alia

'(ii) the office of National Vice President of whom there shall be one from each Branch, these officers shall be nominated by and elected from the Councillors elect except that where a Branch is only entitled to one National Councillor in accordance with the provisions of Rule 76. The person who has been elected Branch President/National Councillor shall be deemed to have also been elected National Vice President.'

As a consequence it will now be necessary to arrange for nominations to be called as soon as possible to fill the vacancy in the office representing Tasmanian Branch.

I shall be obliged therefore if you will arrange for the new election to be conducted.

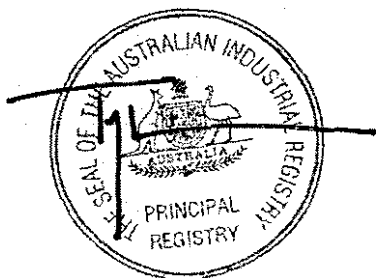
