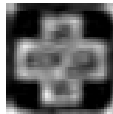
DECISION

ELECTION TO NATIONAL OFFICE

National President, National Vice Presidents

2005

Tuesday 23 August Councillors elect. Names received by national office from Branch Directors following announcement of results of Branch elections.

Friday 26 August Returning Officer calls for nominations for National President and National Vice Presidents from Councillors-elect.

Monday 12 September Nominations close

National President

Tuesday 13 September If only sufficient nominations received to fill position of National President no election is required and the result can be announced by the Returning Officer although the National President-elect will not assume office until the National Council meeting in November.

Monday 19 September If more than one nomination received for the office of National President the Returning Officer shall distribute ballot papers and how to vote instructions with pre-paid envelopes.

Tuesday 4 October Ballot closes at 5pm

Wednesday 5 October Returning Officer counts ballot papers and announces result

National Vice Presidents

Wednesday 12 October If only sufficient nominations have been received by 12 September to fill positions no election is required and the result can be announced by the Returning Officer although the elected office bearers will not assume office until the National Council meeting in November.

Thursday 20 October If more than one nomination has been received for any of the offices of National Vice President the Returning Officer shall distribute ballot papers and how to vote instructions with pre-paid envelopes.

Thursday 3 November Ballot closes at 5pm.

Friday 4 November Returning Officer counts ballot papers and announces result

Tuesday 22 November Returning Office declares election result at National Council meeting.

The term of office for the Guild Office Holders elected in accordance with the foregoing timetable will be three years.
