# Response to Post Election Report

I refer to the Post Election Report issued by the Australian Electional Commission (AEC) dated 2. November 2011 regarding the election (E2011/2533) for the National President position of The Pharmacy Guild of Australia (The Guild). In its report the AEC has identified Rules that are difficult to apply interpret. Responses to these are set out below.

Rules 55Bij)(ii) (A) (ii), Rules 55Bij)(ii) (B) (ii) € (iii), Rules 55Bij)(ii) (C):

The Rule requires that a tied bullot when there are two candidates in the election for National President, be decided by a recount where there is a requirement for weighted votes. Determination by poll us per Rule 22 (a) & (b). This maybe in breach of the secrecy of votes in the ballot.

The Guild notes the concerns raised by the AEC as to the potential for a vote determined by poll (i.e. weighted votes) to potentially compromise the secrecy of the voting process (as required by section 143(1)(e) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 and Rule 55B(h) of the Guild's registered rules). As such, the Guild, through its Constitution and Rules Committee, will conduct a review of the relevant rules to ensure that the process for deciding the result of a field vote also meets the requirements for a secret ballot.

Rule "4 (b) (ii) requires on automatic recall of nominations in the event that there we insufficient nominations in Stage I for the infilled Branch Committee positions.

It is the Guild's opinion that Rule 74(h)(ii) refers to enabling the Returning Officer, after consultation with the Branch Director, to conduct elections for office bearing positions even if all positions on the Branch Committee are not filled in the origina. Stage 1 elections, as long as there are sufficient normations to form a quorum of the Branch Committee. The Rule allows for the calling of normations to fill the vacant position(s) at a date subsequent to the office bearing position elections.

The Guld is of the opinion however that there is no automatic recall provision in the Rules, but rather further elections for unfilled Branch Committee positions will require a new election to be arranged, including the lodging by the Guld of "prescribed information" with Fair Work Australia (FWA), as required by section 189(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations). Act 2009. It is noted that Regulation 138(1)(b)(iv) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Regulations 2009 states that the "prescribed information" to be lodged with FWA for an election includes stating the reason for the election, such as where the office or position was not filled at the previous election.







The RO is able to conduct elections for office bearers betwee the re-call, if there is a quorum of nominations and they must consult with the Branch Director.

The Guild agrees that the Returning Officer is able to, after consultation with the Branch Director, conduct elections for office bearers prior to calling for nominations to fill the vacant position(s) on the Branch Committee, provided that there are sufficient nominations to form a quorum of the Branch Committee at all times.

In the normal course of events, the RO will conduct the re-call for nominations for Branch Committee members before the election for office bourers. At the completion of the re-call election, there is no need for a quorum to exist to proceed to the 2nd stage election for office beavers.

It is the Guild's opinion that the normal course of events as prescribed by the Rule would be to conduct the election for office hearers prior to any further election to fill vacant Branch Committee positions, provided a quorum of Branch Committee nominations exist at the time.

The Guild is of the belief that a quorum of Branch Committee members must exist in order to proceed to the 2<sup>nd</sup> stage elections for office hearers. It is stated in the relevant Rule that the Returning Officer may act as prescribed "(p)rovided that all times there are sufficient nominations to form a quorum of the Branch Committee".



- [1] On 12 April 2011 I made arrangements under subsection 189(3) of the Act for the conduct of an election [[2011] FWAD 2242, [PR508377]] for a number of offices within The Pharmacy Guild of Australia and its Branches.
- [2] On 19 April 2011 and 27 April 2011 I received correspondence from the New South Wales Branch (the Branch) of the organisation. That correspondence sought an amendment of my earlier decision. In particular, the Branch sought the election of, inter alia, 15 New South Wales Branch Committee Members whereas I had made arrangements for the conduct of an election for 12 Branch Committee Members, consistent with the prescribed information which was initially lodged. It seems that following lodgement of the prescribed information but prior to my 12 April 2011 decision, the Branch resolved to increase the number of Branch Committee Members for the forthcoming term of office. However, Fair Work Australia was not made aware of that resolution until 19 April 2011.
- [3] I have examined the rules of The Pharmacy Guild of Australia. I am satisfied that the Branch is entitled to determine the number of its Committee Members as it has done in this case. I am therefore satisfied that an election for the 15 New South Wales Branch Committee Members is required to be held under the rules of the organisation.
