Dear Ms Simmons

I refer to the Post Election Report issued by the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) dated 7 October 2014 regarding the election (E2014/87) for the National President position of The Pharmacy Guild of Australia (The Guild). In its report the AEC has identified Rules that are difficult to apply/interpret. Responses to these are set out below.

Rules 55B(j)(ii) (A) (ii), Rules 55B(j)(ii) (B) (ii) & (iii), Rules 55B(j)(ii) (C) :

The Rule requires that a tied ballot when there are two candidates in the election for National President, be decided by a recount where there is a requirement for weighted votes [Determination by poll as per Rule 22 (a)  $\mathfrak{G}(b)$ ]. This maybe in breach of the secrecy of votes in the ballot.

The Guild notes the concerns raised by the AEC as to the potential for a vote determined by poll (i.e. weighted votes) in accordance with the current Registered Rules to potentially compromise the secrecy of the voting process (as required by section 143(1)(e) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 and Rule 55B(h) of the Guild's registered rules).

As such, the Guild, through its Constitution and Rules Committee, has conducted a review of the relevant rules and has devised potential changes, subject to approval by the Fair Work Commission, to alter the process for deciding the result of a tied vote so as to ensure that the requirements of a secret ballot can also be met.

The proposed changes indicate that in the instance of a tied vote for the position of National President, a second secret ballot will be required. For this second ballot each National Councillor-elect will receive a number of ballot papers that will be calculated by making reference to the number of Financial Members in the Branch as at 30 June immediately preceding the election in which the Voting Councillor-elect was elected, taking into account the number of Councillors-elect from the Voting Councillor's Branch, and dividing this by the number of Financial Members in the Branch with the fewest Financial Members.

The Guild is of the view that the proposed revised process set out above will ensure that the secrecy of the voting process in a second ballot, should it be required, will be maintained.
