That:

1. I am a National Vice President of The Pharmacy Guild of Australia ('the Guild').
2. Vincent Tran, Pharmacist, Branch Committee member, Branch Vice-President and Alternate National Councillor of the ACT Branch of The Pharmacy Guild of Australia resigned as a Branch Committee member on 25 November 2011.

Branch Committee Persons to fill the casual vacancies of Branch Vice-President (2)

Branch Committee Person to fill the casual vacancy of Alternate National Councillor (1)
