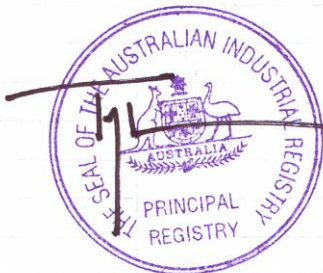
*Arrangement for conduct of election.*
