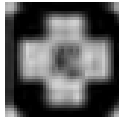

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 189 of Schedule 1B of the Workplace Relations Act 1996, The Pharmacy Guild of Australia submits the following information.

Nominations will be required to be called during the period commencing 20 February 2004 for the following office bearers of the Western Australian Branch of The Pharmacy Guild of Australia.

Branch Committee

1. One Committee person to fill a casual vacancy representing the Fremantle/Melville Zone.

The reason for the election is the sudden death on 18 January 2004 of the previous incumbent Mr Kevin Thomas James McAnuff, pharmacist of 5 Orana Crescent, Brentwood, WA 6153.

2. One Committee person to fill a casual vacancy representing the South West Country zone.

The reason for this election being the failure to attract a candidate during the 2002 Guild elections.

3. National Delegate. One elected Committee person to fill a casual vacancy in the office of National Delegate representing the Western Australian Branch.

The reason for this election being the death of Mr McAnuff referred to in Item 1 above.


4. The roll for voters in the elections will close 14/10 days before nominations are called. The current term of office for these offices expires on 30 September 2005.
