"An organisation must, within the prescribed period, lodge in the Industrial Registry notification of any change made to the records required to be kept under paragraphs 230(1)(b), (c) and (d), certified by declaration signed by the secretary or other prescribed officer of the organisation to be a correct statement of the changes made"

The prescribed period referred to is 35 days of the date of the change of records. I would be pleased if, in future, all changes to the list of office holders or other records could be made within 35 days.
