
**STATEMENT AND NOTICE OF PRESCRIBED INFORMATION

Reasons for election:

As set out in Attachment A. Elections for offices and positions are marked as either requiring election because the terms of office have expired in the normal course of events under the rules of the organisation or are required because they are a new position that has been created under rule 61 of the organisation.

Elected by:

As set out in Attachment A. The electorate for the direct voting system is each respective Zone.

As per rule 66 Clause (b), paragraph (i), sub paragraph (a) of the organisation, each Zone shall be entitled to workplace representation at National Council on the basis of 1 Workplace Delegate per 100 members, or majority part thereof, each of whom shall be elected from the financial members within their Zone.

Rule 66 Clause (b), paragraph (vi) states for the purpose of this rule a Zone Coordinator shall be deemed to be a Workplace Delegate where there is no such position elected within the Zone in accordance with Clause (b), paragraph (i), sub paragraph (a).
