Re: Prescribed Information for PFA election (E2009/10048)

I acknowledge receipt of the prescribed information for the PFA 2009 election of Federal Executive members, Federal President, Federal Vice-Presidents and Federal Treasurer, lodged with Fair Work Australia on 21 September 2009. As mentioned on the phone today, I request that an amended statement which addresses the matters outlined below be lodged as soon as possible.

1) The relevant provision of the Act and Regulations

The heading of the statement and the statement lodged by the Police Federation of Australia refers to subsection 214(1) of the Act. The amended statement needs to refer to subsection 189(1) of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009.

2) The number of vacancies for each office

I note that the statement does not identify the number of Executive Officers. Although this information is included in the attached letter, this is not sufficient to satisfy regulation 138(1)(c) as it is not part of the statement nor is it signed by an officer (as defined by the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009). The amended statement needs to identify the number of Executive Officers.

The kind of voting system

Regulation 138(1)(g)requires the prescribed information to identify whether the voting system is a direct voting system or a collegiate electoral system. I note that the statement lodged describes the voting system as 'first past the post' which, although correct, does not meet the requirements of the regulations. The amended statement needs to identify whether the voting system is direct voting or collegiate.
