Rules used for the election: 200V: Incorporates alterations of 13 July 2021 [R2021/31] (replaces rulebook dated 21 June 2021 [R2021/35])

Rules difficult to apply/interpret:

Rule 52AO 14 (e)(i) caused confusion about how to cast a formal vote with electors for Stage 1 Branch Executive, which resulted in above average number of informal ballot papers being cast. I recommend that in place of 'a cross (X) or tick opposite the name of the candidate for whom they vote' that a single mark on ballot paper is the preferred method.

Other Matters

Returning Officer actions required (Section 193): Yes Details:

- Rules regarding the timetable of the election are set aside as the AEC hold concerns that the coronavirus pandemic may impact on the ability for stakeholders to fully participate in the election. A timetable for the conduct of the ballot is varied from the rules was set when the AEC was satisfied that stakeholders would be able to fully participate.
- Rules specifying the method of lodgement of nominations are set aside as the AEC held concerns that the coronavirus pandemic would impact on the ability for potential candidates to nominate. Instead nominations will be received electronically, via email/the AEC's portal.
- Rules regarding the Stage 2 timetable of the election are set aside as the AEC held concerns that the coronavirus pandemic may impact on the ability for stakeholders to fully participate in the election. Therefore, the AEC decided to conduct Stage 2 (elections for Branch Office Bearers and Federal Council Delegates) as a postal ballot instead of an attendance. A shortened ballot period was applied of 2 weeks and subsequently a change of timetable occurring 2 days prior to the initial agreed upon ballot choose date. This was agreed upon by the AEC and PFA WA and the scrutiny was conducted on 24/11/2021 instead of 26/11/2021.
