95(5)(bA) Nominations may be withdrawn up to and including 5 working days after the time and date the Returning Officer has declared that nominations shall close. The withdrawal of such nomination shall be in the form determined by the Returning Officer and shall be signed by the nominee.

Due to the COVID 19 Pandemic the Special National Council was cancelled and has been rescheduled to 30 July 2020.
